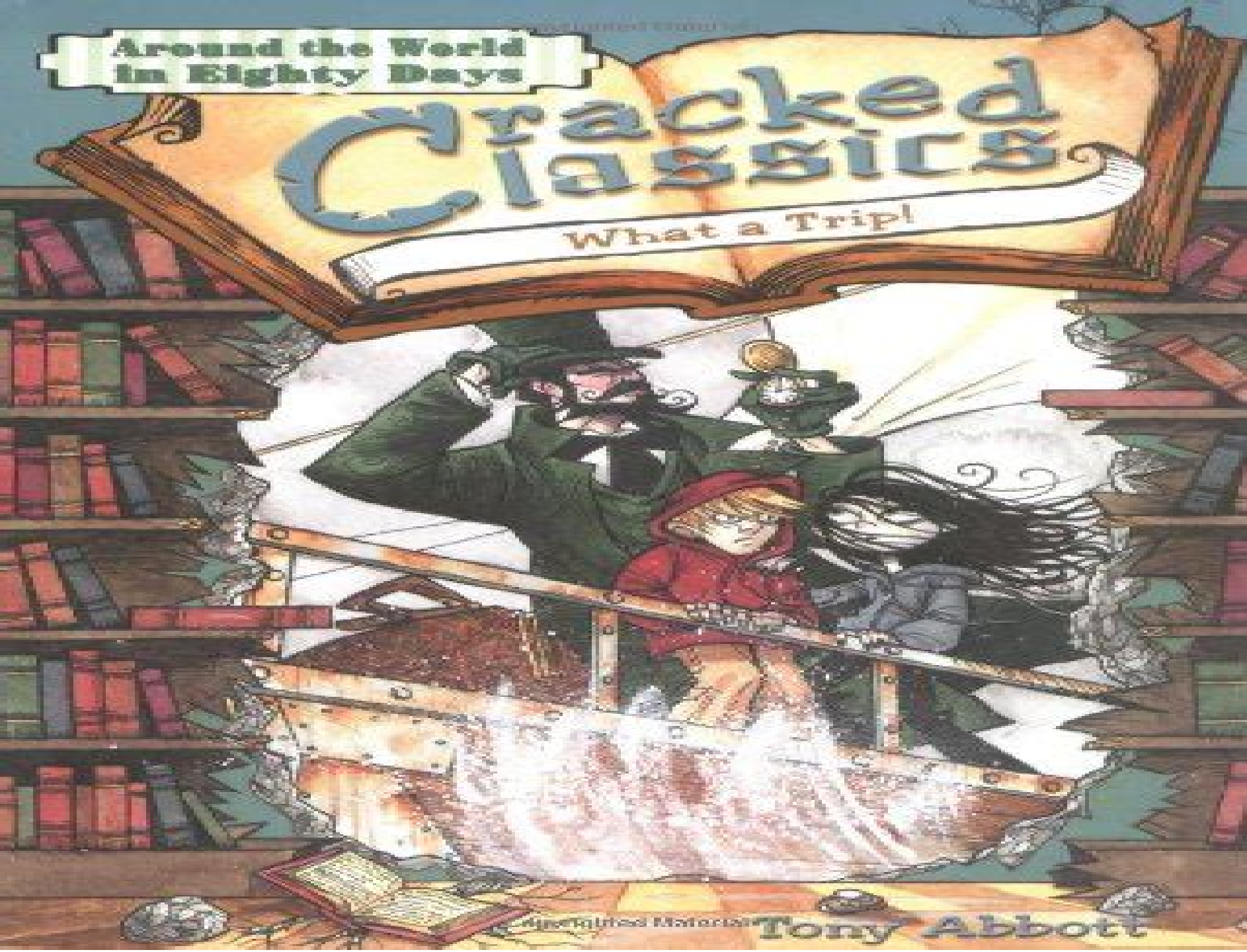

"Throw the book away" Amie A. Doughty, 2013-05-11 Children's literature is an excellent way to educate children on everything from social behavior and beliefs to attitudes toward education itself. A major aspect of children's literature is the importance of books and reading. Books represent adult authority. This book examines the role that books, reading and writing play in children's fantasy fiction from books that act as artifacts of power: The Abhorsen Trilogy, The Spiderwick Chronicles, Harry Potter to interactive books: The Neverending Story, Malice Inkheart to books with character writers: Percy Jackson, Captain Underpants. The author finds that although books and reading often play a prominent role in fantasy for children, the majority of young protagonists gain self-sufficiency not by reading but specifically by moving beyond books and reading.
