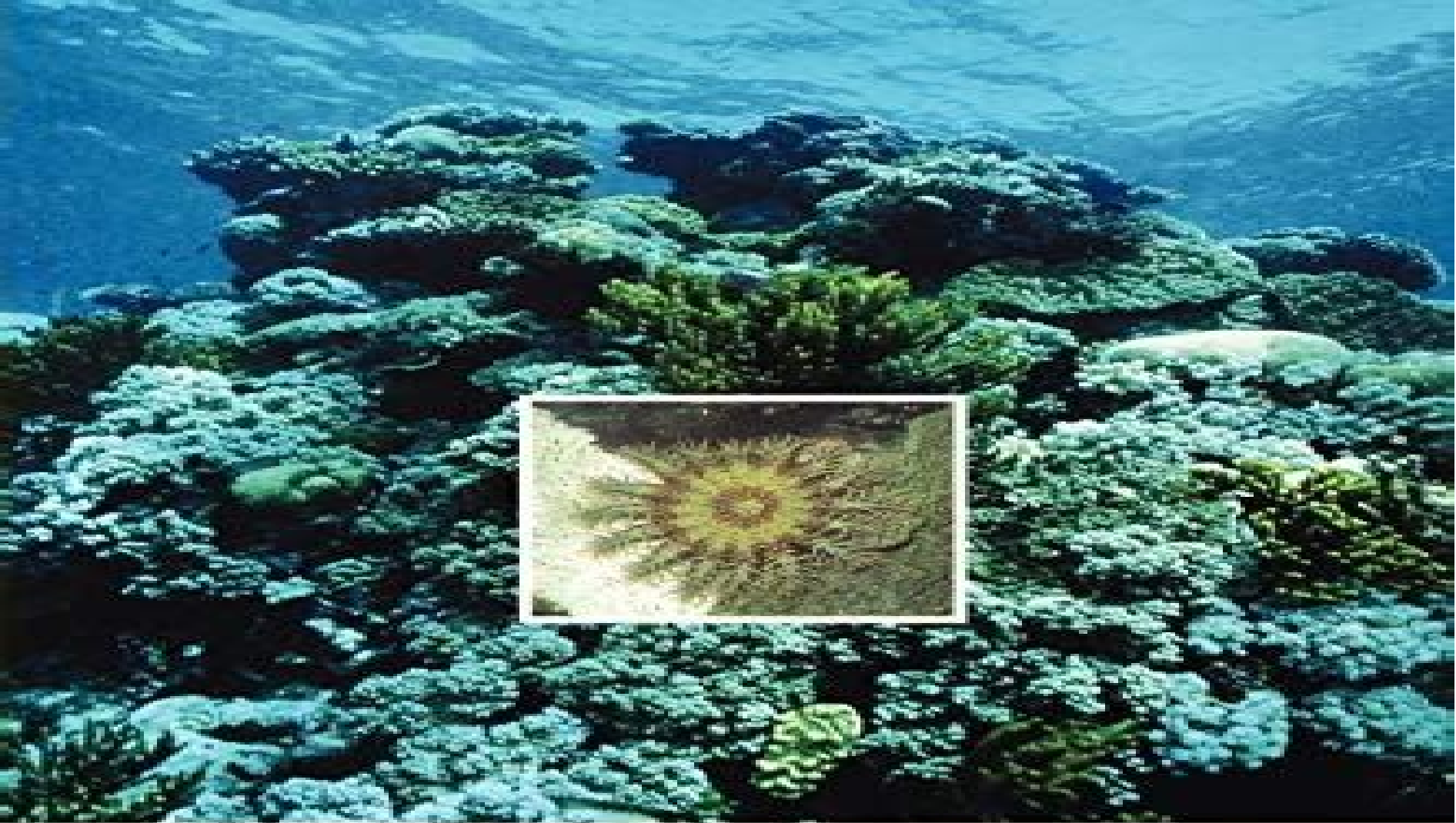

This book provides a unique perspective on the destruction both natural and human caused of coral reef ecosystems. Reconstructing the ecological history of coral reefs the authors evaluate whether recent dramatic changes are novel events or part of a long term trend or cycle. The text combines principles of geophysics, paleontology and marine sciences with real time observation examining the interacting causes of change: hurricane damage, predators, disease, rising sea level, nutrient loading, global warming and ocean acidification. Predictions about the future of coral reefs inspire strategies for restoration and management of ecosystems.
