The essays in *The Other Missouri History* explore a wide range of topics in Missouri social history. By dealing with the lives of ordinary Missourians, these pieces examine the effects of significant social and economic change at all levels of society. With a broader scope in Missouri history than previous studies, this book demonstrates how Missourians have been affected by issues of race, class, and gender. Gregg Andrews's essay, "The Racial Politics of Reconstruction in Ralls County, 1865-1870," examines how race shaped the political culture in Ralls County during the Reconstruction Era. Andrews argues that race-baiting was used prominently by editors of the *Ralls County Record* to discredit radicals in the county and was perhaps the most powerful political weapon that conservatives and later Democrats could use to gain the allegiance of voters. Farmers are another popular topic for *The Other Missouri History*. Michael J. Steiner's "The Failure of Alliance Populism in Northern Missouri" provides insight into the economic and rhetorical reasons for the failure of Populism in Missouri. Steiner contends that white farmers in northern Missouri were happy with the status quo and rejected calls for radical reform and major change in the agricultural economy. Women began to become active in public life during the late nineteenth and early

twentieth centuries Janice Brandon Falcone's *Constance Runcie and the Runcie Club of St Joseph* examines the first two decades of an important women's club that still exists in St Joseph Missouri Also included in *The Other Missouri History* are essays by Deborah J Henry Daniel A Graff Bonnie Stepenoff Robert Faust and Amber R Clifford Because of the diverse issues addressed this volume will appeal to general readers of Missouri and Midwestern history as well as to those who teach courses in history and have sought a supplemental text

Women in American Politics: History and Milestones Doris Weatherford, 2012-01-20 *Women in American Politics* is a new reference detailing the milestones and trends in women's political participation in the United States This two volume work provides much needed perspective and background on the events and situations that have surrounded women's political activities It offers insightful analysis on women's political achievements in the United States including such topics as the campaign to secure nation wide suffrage pioneer women state officeholders women first elected to U S Congress governorships mayoralities and other offices and women first appointed as Cabinet officials judges and ambassadors It also includes profiles of the women who have run for vice president and president *Women in American Politics* is organized in a framework both logical and useful to readers and researchers Original material offers students scholars teachers and other professionals a guide to understanding the complex struggle in women's progress toward achieving political parity with men in the United States Each chapter is structured in three parts part one features graphic information tables lists charts or maps detailing the historical record with data not compiled anywhere else on women officeholders part two offers insightful narrative analysis describing how women achieved what they did examines the complex and sometimes contradictory trends behind the facts of women's political milestones and explores how social and economic contexts affected the progress of their accomplishments part three presents biographical entries describing in more personal terms women's struggle for political equality Sidebars in each chapter illuminate the drama of political life and consider the evolving female electorate exploring how women voters have impacted particular issues specific elections or other key turning points and the tradition of appointing widows to open seats The final chapter uniquely looks at women's political history and differences in achievement from a state and regional perspective Entries on each state as well as on District of Columbia and Puerto Rico highlight milestones and provide insight into the unique aspects of each state

On Slavery's Border Diane Mutti Burke, 2010-12-01 *On Slavery's Border* is a bottom up examination of how slavery and slaveholding were influenced by both the geography and the scale of the slaveholding enterprise Missouri's strategic access to important waterways made it a key site at the periphery of the Atlantic world By the time of statehood in 1821 people were moving there in large numbers especially from the upper South hoping to replicate the slave society they'd left behind Diane Mutti Burke focuses on the Missouri counties located along the Mississippi and Missouri rivers to investigate small scale slavery at the level of the household and neighborhood She examines such topics as small slaveholders child rearing and fiscal strategies the economics of slavery relations between slaves and owners the challenges

faced by slave families sociability among enslaved and free Missourians within rural neighborhoods and the disintegration of slavery during the Civil War Mutti Burke argues that economic and social factors gave Missouri slavery an especially intimate quality Owners directly oversaw their slaves and lived in close proximity with them sometimes in the same building White Missourians believed this made for a milder version of bondage Some slaves who expressed fear of being sold further south seemed to agree Mutti Burke reveals however that while small slaveholding created some advantages for slaves it also made them more vulnerable to abuse and interference in their personal lives In a region with easy access to the free states the perception that slavery was threatened spawned white anxiety which frequently led to violent reassertions of supremacy

African American Lives in St. Louis, 1763-1865 Dale Edwynna Smith, 2017-02-07 The African American presence in St Louis began in 1763 with the arrival of several free men of color who accompanied Pierre Laclede from New Orleans to set up a fur trading fort on the Mississippi Within a few decades the fort had become a prosperous commercial center whose proximity to the western frontier attracted a cosmopolitan community African Americans in St Louis both slave and free enjoyed greater autonomy and opportunity than those in urban areas of the South and East Slaves in the city set legal precedent by filing hundreds of freedom suits often based on the prohibition against slavery set by the Northwest Ordinance of 1787 After a century in the region many blacks enlisted in the Union Army during the Civil War Drawing on a wide range of sources the author studies the history of slaves and free blacks in this city Encyclopedia of African American History, 1896 to the Present Paul Finkelman, 2009 Alphabetically arranged entries from A to C that explores significant events major persons organizations and political and social movements in African American history from 1896 to the twenty first century

Deblack,2002-03-01 Elites have shaped southern life and communities argues the distinguished historian Willard Gatewood These essays written by Gatewood's colleagues and former students in his honor explore the influence of particular elites in the South from the American Revolution to the Little Rock integration crisis They discuss not only the power of elites to shape the experiences of the ordinary people but the tensions and negotiations between elites in a particular locale whether those elites were white or black urban or rural or male or female Subjects include the particular kinds of power available to black elites in Savannah Georgia during the American Revolution the transformation of a southern secessionist into an anti slavery activist during the Civil War a Tennessee aristocrat of color active in politics from Reconstruction to World War II middle class Southern women both black and white in the New Deal and the Little Rock integration crisis and the different brands of paternalism in Arkansas plantations during the Jacksonian and Jim Crow eras and in the postwar Georgia carpet industry

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
