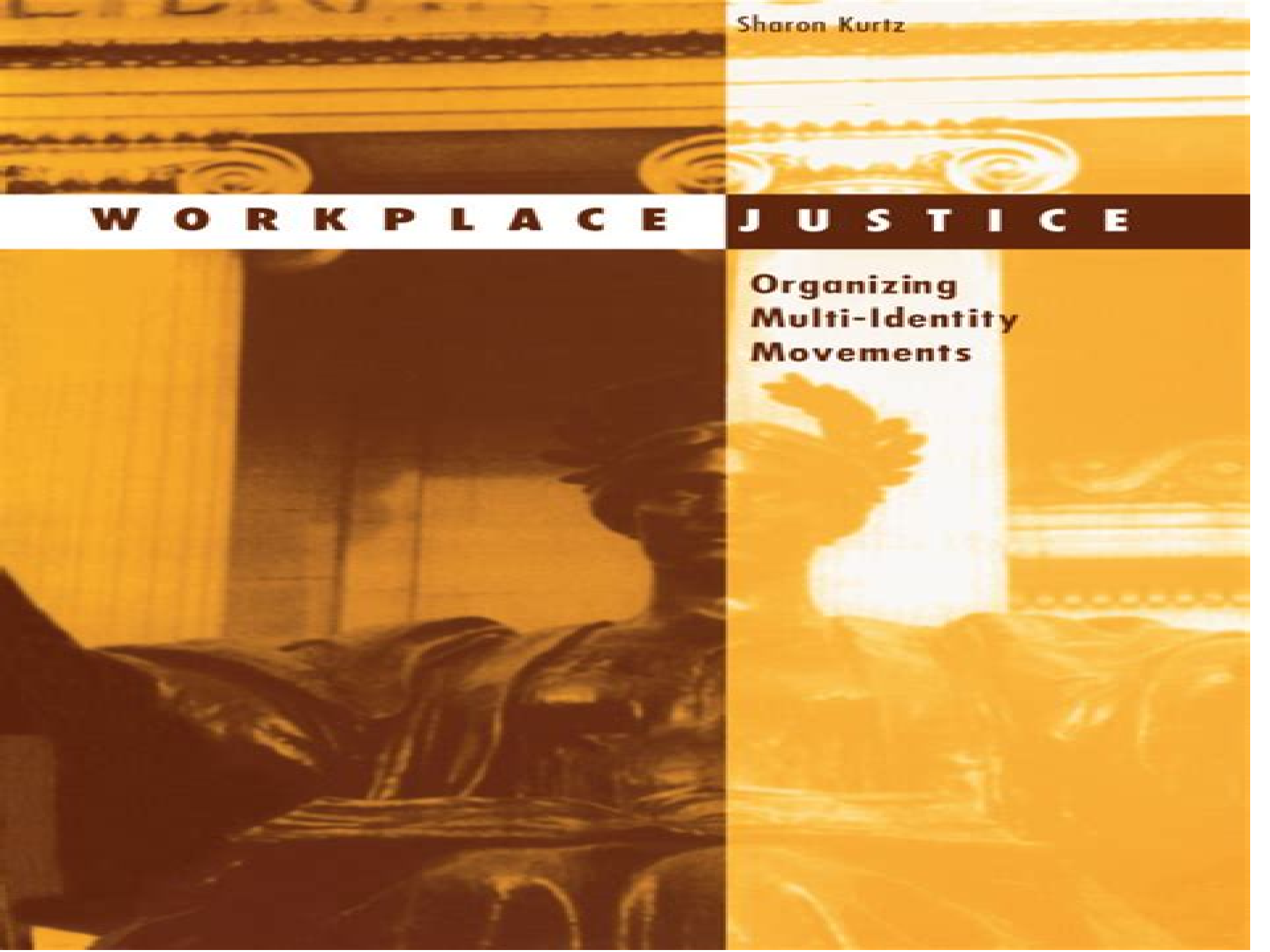

Workplace Justice, 2002 **Workplace Justice** Sharon Kurtz, 2002 In 1991 Columbia University's one thousand clerical workers launched a successful campaign for justice in their workplace This diverse union two thirds black and Latina three fourths women was committed to creating an inclusive movement organization and to fighting for all kinds of justice How could they address the many race and gender injustices members faced avoid schism and maintain the unity needed to win Sharon Kurtz an experienced union activist and former clerical worker herself was welcomed into the union and pursued these questions Using this case study and secondary studies of sister clerical unions at Yale and Harvard she examines the challenges and potential of identity politics in labor movements With the Columbia strike as a point of departure Kurtz argues that identity politics are valuable for mobilizing groups but often exclude members and their experiences of oppression However Kurtz believes that identity politics should not be abandoned as a component in building movements but should be reframed as multi identity politics In the end she shows an approach to organizing with great potential impact not only for labor unions but for any social movement

Stories of Inclusion? Deborah A. Piatelli, 2009-01-16 Why are some white middle class activists experiencing difficulty creating alliances across racial and class differences What are the obstacles and what is being done to overcome them What type of movement structures cultures and practices can best facilitate inter racial inter class solidarity Stories of Inclusion explores these questions through an ethnographic study of a predominately white middle class contemporary peace and justice network that is working to create a racially and class diverse community of activists Addressing a very significant and greatly under researched topic Stories of Inclusion raises important and critical questions for the peace movement as well as larger society In accessible prose this study bridges the literatures of social movement theory critical race studies and feminist theory and offers new insight into how power and privilege can affect the process of creating inclusive communities Drawing on data the author collected through in depth interviews interpretive focus groups and over two years of participant observation this study explores how white middle class privilege influences political analyses definitions of peace work and approaches to alliance building The findings are compelling and reveal that even those who have developed an oppositional political consciousness and have pledged to work across racial and class divides can still foster exclusive organizing practices This study also offers examples on how some activists are acknowledging privilege transforming their worldviews and beginning to establish fruitful relationships across differences This important work emphasizes the continuing importance of race for those collective actors attempting to construct inclusive movements across diverse groups while also offering important practical solutions on how to bridge differences The conclusion offers a framework for building a new agenda for the peace and justice movement

Changing Corporate America from Inside Out Nicole Christine Raeburn, 2004 Despite the backlash against lesbian and gay rights occurring in cities and states across the country a growing number of corporations are actually expanding protections and benefits for their gay and lesbian employees Why this should be and why some corporations are increasingly open to inclusive policies while others are determinedly not is what Nicole C Raeburn seeks to explain in *Changing Corporate America from Inside Out* A long overdue study of the workplace movement Raeburn's analysis focuses on the mobilization of lesbian gay and bisexual employee networks over the past fifteen years to win domestic partner benefits in Fortune 1000 companies Drawing on surveys of nearly one hundred corporations with and without gay networks intensive interviews with human resources executives and gay employee activists as well as a number of case studies Raeburn reveals the impact of the larger social and political environment on corporations openness to gay inclusive policies the effects of industry and corporate characteristics on companies willingness to adopt such policies and what strategies have been most effective in transforming corporate policies and practices to support equitable benefits for all workers Nicole C Raeburn is assistant professor and chair of sociology at the University of San Francisco

[Fighting for Peace](#) Lisa Leitz, 2014-04-15 *Fighting for Peace* brings to light an important yet neglected aspect of opposition to the Iraq War the role of veterans and their families Drawing on extensive participant observation and interviews Lisa Leitz demonstrates how the harrowing war experiences of veterans and their families motivated a significant number of them to engage in peace activism Married to a Navy pilot herself Leitz documents how military peace activists created a movement that allowed them to merge two seemingly contradictory sides of their lives an intimate relation to the military and antiwar activism Members of the movement strategically deployed their combined military peace activist identities to attract media attention assert their authority about the military and war and challenge dominant pro war sentiment By emphasizing the human costs of war activists hoped to mobilize American citizens and leaders who were detached from the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan bring the wars to an end and build up programs to take care of returning veterans and their families The stories in *Fighting for Peace* ultimately reveal that America's all volunteer force is contributing to a civilian military divide that

leaves civilians with little connection to the sacrifices of the military Increasingly Leitz shows veterans and their families are being left to not only fight America's wars but also to fight against them **Waves of Protest** Paul D. Almeida, 2008-01-01 One of the first longitudinal studies of collective resistance in the developing world Waves of Protest examines large scale contentious action in El Salvador during critical eras in the country's history Providing a compelling analysis of the massive waves of protests from the early twentieth century to the present in El Salvador Paul D Almeida fully chronicles one of the largest and most successful campaigns against globalization and privatization in the Americas Drawing on original protest data from newspapers and other archival sources Almeida makes an impassioned argument that regime liberalization organizes civil society and conversely acts of state sponsored repression radicalize society He correlates the ebb and flow of protest waves to the changes in regime liberalization and subsequent de democratization and back to liberalization Almeida shows how institutional access and competitive elections create opportunity for civic organizations that become radicalized when authoritarianism increases resulting at times in violent protest campaigns that escalate to revolutionary levels In doing so he brings negative political conditions and threats to the forefront as central forces driving social movement activity and popular contention in the developing world Paul D Almeida is assistant professor of sociology at Texas A M University He is coeditor with Hank Johnston of Latin American Social Movements Globalization Democratization and Transnational Networks

Fighting for the Future of Food Rachel Schurman, William A.
