

Well Child Visits & Newborn Follow-ups

Well Child Visits serve as a forum to review your baby's growth, nutrition, day to day activities and development. They are scheduled following the recommendations for preventive health care set by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP). During these visits, we often administer recommended vaccinations and obtain recommended tests. During the first two years of life, these visits are generally conducted as follows:

3-5 Days	Newborn Follow-Up	Baby's feeding, weight loss and jaundice (additional follow-ups may be necessary)
2 Weeks	Well Child Visit	Weight Follow-up
1 Month	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
2 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
4 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
6 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
9 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
12 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations, Blood Count, Lead
15 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
18 Months	Well Child Visit	Immunizations
2 Years	Well Child Visit	Immunizations, Blood Count, Lead
30 Months	Well Child Visit	Catch-up Immunizations
3 Years	Well Child Visit	Catch-up Immunizations
Once a Year Thereafter
