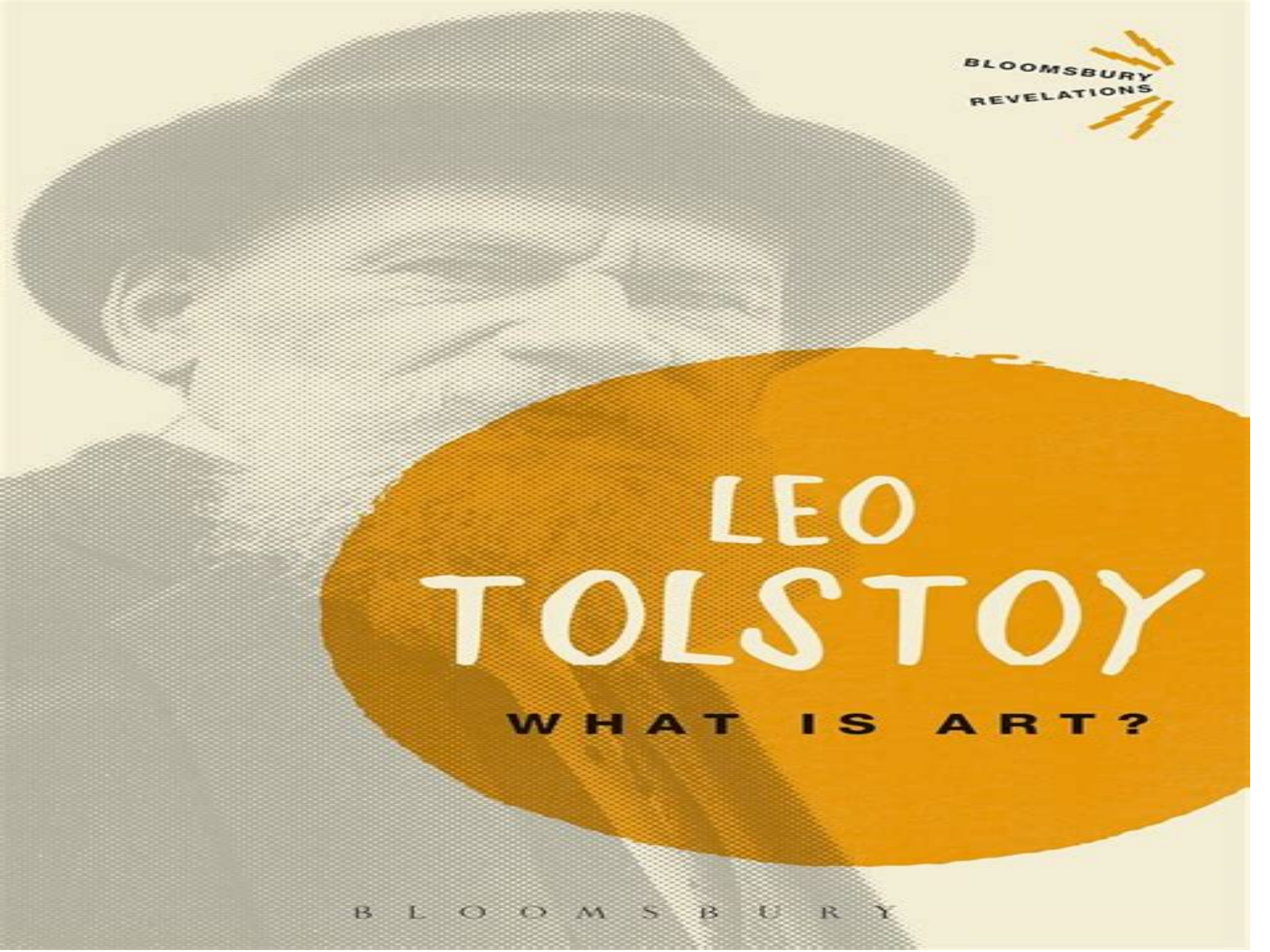

What is Art? graf Leo Tolstoy,2020 Leo Tolstoy is one of the most celebrated novelists of all time As well as writing literary classics such as Anna Karenina and War and Peace he was also the author of some hugely influential critical and philosophical works First published in 1898 his book length essay What is Art has lost none of its power to challenge our perception of art and its function in society today In this provocative work Tolstoy famously dismisses works by Shakespeare Dante Wagner and even many of his own works as bad art based on various criteria including sincerity ethics morality and accessibility Tolstoy took art seriously at a time when western civilization toyed with it as a mere pastime during the height of the Aestheticism movement For him art was natural and necessary to the advancement of humankind In his introduction to this translation W Gareth Jones shows how vitally Tolstoy s personality and experiences in life were engaged in creating What is Art Jones shows how integral the essay was to his art and teaching and why it continues to demand a response from us
