The Passage to Cosmos Laura Dassow Walls, 2009-09-15 Explorer scientist writer and humanist Alexander von Humboldt was the most famous intellectual of the age that began with Napoleon and ended with Darwin With *Cosmos* the book that crowned his career Humboldt offered to the world his vision of humans and nature as integrated halves of a single whole In it Humboldt espoused the idea that while the universe of nature exists apart from human purpose its beauty and order the very idea of the whole it composes are human achievements *cosmos* comes into being in the dance of world and mind subject and object science and poetry Humboldt's science laid the foundations for ecology and inspired the theories of his most important scientific disciple Charles Darwin In the United States his ideas shaped the work of Emerson Thoreau Poe and Whitman They helped spark the American environmental movement through followers like John Muir and George Perkins Marsh And they even bolstered efforts to free the slaves and honor the rights of Indians Laura Dassow Walls here traces Humboldt's ideas for *Cosmos* to his 1799 journey to the Americas where he first experienced the diversity of nature and of the world's peoples and envisioned a new cosmopolitanism that would link ideas disciplines and nations into a global web of knowledge and cultures In reclaiming Humboldt's transcultural and transdisciplinary project Walls situates America in a lively and contested field of ideas actions and interests and reaches beyond to a new worldview that integrates the natural and social sciences the arts and the humanities To the end of his life Humboldt called himself half an American but ironically his legacy has largely faded in the United States *The Passage to Cosmos* will reintroduce this seminal thinker to a new audience and return America to its rightful place in the story of his life work and enduring legacy *Henry David Thoreau* Michael Berger, 2025-08-01 Thoreau is well known as a lyrical nature writer environmental prophet rebel against stifling convention and theorist of strategic intervention to protest injustice He was also a part time surveyor and pencil maker student of Native America abolitionist philosopher and shrewd Transcendentalist Whether living at Walden Pond or comfortably on Main Street in central Concord Thoreau made deep inquiries into life and gave all to his craft Drawing on the work of outstanding scholars and critics this companion provides information on the full body of Thoreau's work his life and his world connecting the factors that affected Thoreau's thought and writing and highlighting his impact in his own time and since This study brings these various aspects

Starna's *A Son of the Forest* and little known works such as colonial Indian conversion narratives he explores the ways in which these texts reflect and shape the intercultural world from which they arose In doing so Bellin reaches surprising conclusions that *Walden* addresses economic clashes and partnerships between Indians and whites that William

Bartram's Travels encodes competing and interpenetrating systems of Indian and white landholding that Catherine Sedgwick's Hope Leslie enacts the antebellum drama of Indian conversion that James Fenimore Cooper and Henry Wadsworth Longfellow struggled with Indian authors such as George Copway and David Cusick for physical ideological and literary control of the nation The Demon of the Continent proves Indians to be actors in the dynamic processes in which America and its literature are inescapably embedded Shifting the focus from textual images to the sites of material ideological linguistic and aesthetic interaction between peoples Bellin reenvision American literature as the product of contact conflict accommodation and interchange

Johnson, 2007 Why hasn't democracy been embraced worldwide as the best form of government Aesthetic critics of democracy such as Carlyle and Nietzsche have argued that modern democracy by removing the hierarchical institutions that once elevated society's character turns citizens into bland mediocre souls Joel A Johnson now offers a rebuttal to these critics drawing surprising inspiration from American literary classics Addressing the question from a new perspective Johnson takes a fresh look at the worth of liberal democracy in these uncertain times and tackles head on the thorny question of cultural development Examining the novels of James Fenimore Cooper Mark Twain and William Dean Howells he shows that through their fiction we can gain a better appreciation of the rich detail of everyday life making the debate relevant to contemporary discussions of liberal democracy Johnson focuses on an issue that liberals have inadequately addressed whether people tend to develop fully as individuals under liberal democracy when such a regime does little formally to encourage their development He argues that though the liberal fear of state guided culture is well founded it should not prevent us from evaluating liberalism's effect on individual flourishing By extending the debate over the worthiness of liberal democracy to include democracy's effect on individual development he contends that the democratic experience is much fuller than the aristocratic one and thus expands the faculties of its citizens Critics of American democracy such as John Rawls have sought to transform it into a social or egalitarian democracy in the European style Johnson shows that neither the debate between Rawls and his communitarian critics nor the ongoing discussion of the globalization of American values adequately addresses the fundamental critique of democratic culture advanced by the aesthetic critics Johnson's cogent analysis reaches out to those readers who are ready
