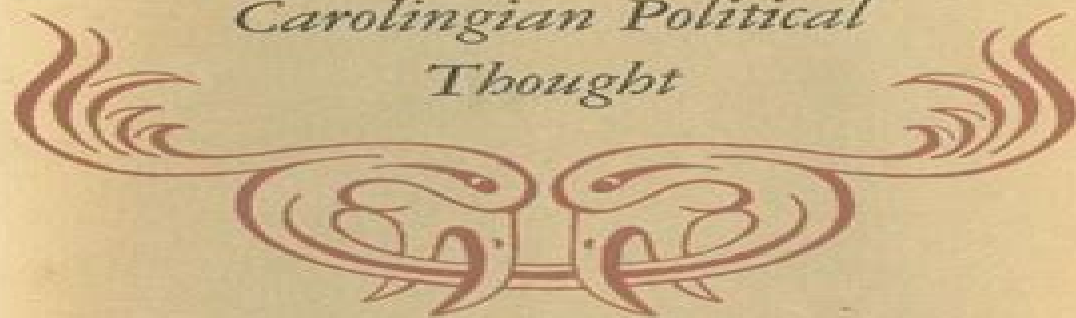

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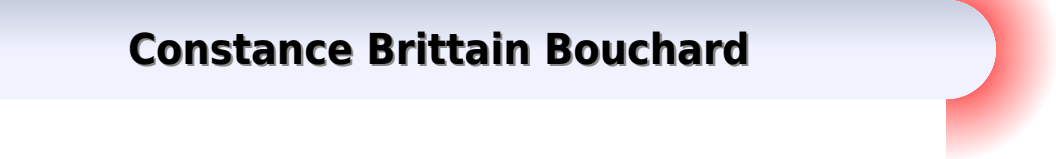

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The External School in Carolingian Society Hildebrandt, 2021-09-20 This study explores one means of imparting Latin literacy in early medieval society the so called external school often presumed to have been a common feature of medieval monastic education It questions the prevalence of this institution and whether the external school can be used as evidence of relatively widespread literacy among the non clerical Carolingian population in particular By precisely defining and chronicling external schooling M M Hildebrandt invites the reader to reconsider conventional notions about the nature of the Carolingian educational program The author examines the intention of monastic founders and writers regarding education the effects of missionary activities on the religious training of non monks the attempts made by royal and ecclesiastical leaders to rationalize external schooling and the impact of ninth century political and economic turmoil on the development of this institution The scope of this book makes it of interest as a contribution to the current debate concerning the character of medieval literacy as well as a source book for the study of early medieval monastic education

**Rethinking Authority in the Carolingian Empire** Rutger Kramer, 2025-10-01 By the early ninth century the responsibility for a series of social religious and political transformations had become an integral part of running the Carolingian empire This became especially clear when in 813 4 Louis the Pious and his court seized the momentum generated by their predecessors and broadened the scope of these reforms ever further

These reformers knew they represented a movement greater than the sum of its parts the interdependence between those wielding imperial authority and those bearing responsibility for ecclesiastical reforms was driven by comprehensive yet still surprisingly diverse expectations Taking this diversity as a starting point this book takes a fresh look at the optimistic first decades of the ninth century Extrapolating from a series of detailed case studies rather than presenting a new grand narrative it offers new interpretations of contemporary theories of personal improvement and institutional correctio and shows the self awareness of its main instigators as they pondered what it meant to be a good Christian in a good Christian empire

submission or commendation and more Ritual asks Philippe Buc In The Dangers of Ritual he boldly argues that the concept shouldn't be so central after all Modern day scholars gently seduced by twentieth century theories of ritual often misinterpret medieval documents that ostensibly describe such events in part because they fail to appreciate the intentions behind them The book begins with four case studies whose arrangement backward from texts on tenth century kingship to fourth century representations of Christian martyrdom allows for the line of development to be peeled back layer by layer It then turns to an analysis of the formation of the intellectual traditions that contemporary historians have employed to interpret medieval documents Tracing the emergence of the concept of ritual from the Reformation to the mid twentieth century Buc highlights the continuities yet also the profound transformations between the early medieval understandings and our own social scientific models Medieval historians will find this book an indispensable resource for its insights into methodological issues crucial to their discipline As Buc demonstrates only rigorous attention to the contexts within which authors worked can allow us to reconstruct from medieval documents how rituals might have functioned Ultimately he argues too swift an application of contemporary models to highly complex textual artifacts blinds us to the specificities of early medieval European political culture
