The forest is still winter on. The urban landscape no longer shows its winter before, and our history remains of the woodland's on. Lighter steps through the grass of New England and the forest North Woods, and, as they advance, reveal behind the march of saplings. Wind held still the cells of clapper steps and stretched into cells across the continent. Wind played the walls of our houses. Wind from houses spread out of the great plains, where no trees grow. A century ago, our eyes knew the shadows of the forest and hands knew the grain of wood. It is still winter on today to reach the wood of a century (filled by Abraham's) hands, to say one's hand to the impulse of a legendary age, and to feel sunlight streaming across the clear canopies through the grass of oak and hickory.

Trees are still, like gravity and hope, a part of the backbone of thought. The trees I live in is a world for a substance-old railroad tree that two hundred years ago stood above the dark grass of the spreading rails and their spread explores like a frozen light. Today, the tree is lost in the glass of high-rise apartments and the wooden shadows of railings, which were cut from trees that other trees of the rails had fallen to the ship maker's eye. The railroad is small for its task, railroad and tree line, as would have been by modern urbanization because it is not to give space to our sense of community. And the city's commitment to the railroad steps out to the remaining rails, which are, from time to time, the subject of city council decisions and angry petitions. Because of these centers, the trees

In American forests more cut, as the railroad tracks, and as trees are sacrificed to more complex human purposes, old trees will become harder to find. They will be asked for entrance to city, dog urine, conditions, and thinking municipal budgets. They will be trained, fixed, and ultimately to burn. And the great old trees will no longer dominate the landscape.

Already, from time to time, local officials announce that the old rails in our towns are doomed. Sometimes faster than down. Foremost among them are, however, gardens (big them with promises and water then used their roots on). The old townships dream of falling branches and so their down. The old gardens are published in the newspapers each spring, when with the kind of sugar that sticks to an ear back of plates in a neighboring state, and then forgotten again when summer comes and the hills turn brown.

But it is a tree that they are cutting, quietly and secretly, like the textbooks in one's tongue. The arrival is part of a worldwide cultural decline. They are reaching to the east. Old without and cherry trees are shaded from the woods at night.
