Mallmann Showell, 2014-03-24 Ocean going U boats each one not much longer than four European articulated lorries with up to sixty men inside them sailed the far off seas to reap havoc in hot inhospitable waters The air forces and navies from Britain the United States and other colonial countries followed to make this a daring and death threatening venture The facts of what the U boats achieved against massive odds have been told before but *U Boats of the Second World War Their Longest Voyages* is different It concentrates more on how it was done How the men survived how they lived and died and how they still found time to carry out their orders The book is based on masses of previously unpublished documents from the German U boat Museum many of them written during or shortly after the war by men who survived this bitter conflict This is the story of how specially built long range ocean going U boats started out one step ahead of the Allied navies and air power how they fell one step behind and how they finally vanished into the depths of the biggest and deepest oceans This is a remarkable story of endurance courage and comradeship that terrified the world for the most critical period of the Second World War The author Jak P Mallmann Showell is the son of a U boat diesel mechanic who disappeared in those warm waters two months before the author was born

U-Boats in New England Eric Wiberg, 2019-11-03 Starting weeks after Hitler declared war on the United States in mid December 1941 and lasting until the war with Germany was all but over 73 German U Boats sustainably attacked New England waters from Montauk New York to the tip of Nova Scotia at Cape Sable Fifteen percent of these boats were sunk by Allied counter attacks five surrendered in the region and three were sunk off New England Block Island Massachusetts Bay and off Nantucket These have proven appealing to divers with a result that at least three German naval officers or ratings are buried in New England one having killed himself in the Boston jail cell There were 34 Allied merchant or naval ships sunk by these subs one of them the *Eagle* was not admitted to have been sunk by the Germans until decades later Over 1 100 men were thrown in the water and 545 of them made it ashore in New England ports 428 were killed Importantly saboteurs were landed three places Long Island Frenchman s Bay Maine and New Brunswick Canada and Boston was mined Very little was known about this

The Corsairs' Longest Voyage Porsteinn Helgason, 2018-03-20 During the summer of 1627 corsairs from Algiers and Sal Morocco undertook the long voyage to Iceland where they raided the eastern and southern regions of the country resulting in the deaths of around thirty people and capturing about 400 further individuals who were sold on the slave markets Around 10% of the captives were ransomed the next twenty years mostly through the efforts of the Danish monarchy In this volume the history of these extraordinary events and their long lasting memory are traced and analysed from the viewpoints of maritime warfare cultural encounters and existential options based on extensive use of various sources from several languages

forgotten campaign The battle began in August 1943 when a German submarine arrived in the Malaysian harbor of Georgetown In total nearly forty U boats were assigned to penetrate the Indian Ocean serving alongside troops of the occupying Imperial Japanese forces The Japanese allowed U boats to use Malaysia as an operational station From that base they mixed with Japanese forces on a hitherto unseen scale a move which spread the U boat war throughout the vast Indian Ocean and into the Pacific Success in this theater of war held a real chance to swing the tide of battle in North Africa in favor of Rommel but the Germans essentially did too little too late The joint action also gave U boats the opportunity to penetrate the Pacific Ocean for the first time attacking shipping off the Australian coast and hunting off New Zealand Plans were even afoot for an assault on American supply lines The cooperation also brought into stark relief the fundamental differences of German and Japanese war aims After the crews of Italian supply submarines joined the Germans and Japanese relations between the fighting men of the three main Axis powers were often brutal and almost constantly turbulent Stories of U boats laden with gold and treasure stem almost exclusively from boats destined to and returning from Japanese controlled Malaysia laden with material exchanged between the two major partners of the Triple Axis Alliance

somewhat reasonable to Chamberlain and his supporters With Germany resurgent and rearmed after the disasters inflicted on it by the Treaty of Versailles following World War I the pact known as the Munich Agreement held out hope of a quick end to German ambitions and the return of stable normal international relations across Europe Of course the Munich agreement is now notorious because its promise proved barren within a very short period of time Chamberlain s actions either failed to avert or actually hastened the very cataclysm he wished to avoid at all costs The Munich Agreement of 1938 effectively signed away Czechoslovakia s independence to Hitler s hungry new Third Reich and within two years most of the world found itself plunged into a conflict which made a charnelhouse of Europe and left somewhere between 60 80 million people dead globally Many people hailed Chamberlain s success at defusing Nazi aggression by handing over Czechoslovakia tamely to Hitler s control but others remained dubious douard Daladier the French prime minister later told Amery that he turned up his coat collar to protect his face from rotten eggs when he arrived in Paris Gilbert 1963 179 180 A Foreign Office man Orme Sargent was disgusted and he later said bitterly For all the fun and cheers you might think they were celebrating a major victory over an enemy instead of merely the betrayal of a minor ally Gilbert 1963 180 Winston Churchill the deal s most famous critic bitterly remarked England has been offered a choice between war and shame She has chosen shame and will get war Europe s attempts to appease him most notably at Munich in 1938 failed as Nazi Germany swallowed up Austria and Czechoslovakia by 1939 Italy was on the march as well invading Albania in April of 1939 The straw that broke the camel s back however was Germany s invasion of Poland on September 1 of that year Two days later France and Great Britain declared war on Germany and World War II had begun in earnest Of course as most people now know the invasion of Poland was merely the preface to the Nazi blitzkrieg of most of Western Europe which would include Denmark Belgium and France by the summer of 1940 The resistance put up by these countries is often portrayed as weak and the narrative is that the British stood alone in 1940 against the Nazi onslaught defending the British Isles during the Battle of Britain and preventing a potential German invasion *The Hidden Places of World War II* Jerome M.
