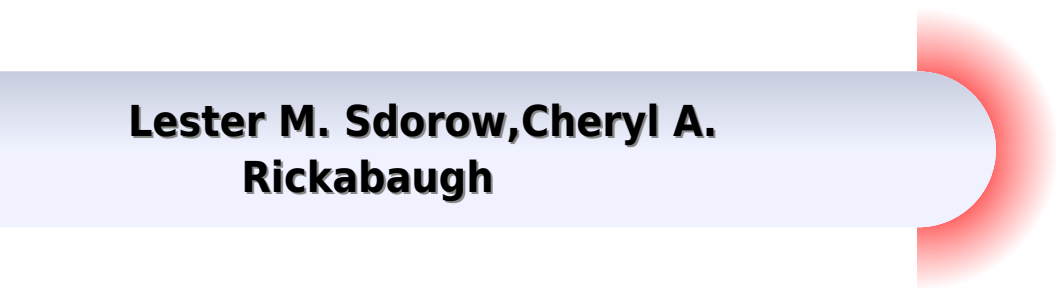

Whales and Dolphins Philippa Brakes, Mark Peter Simmonds, 2013-09-13 Whales and dolphins are icons for the conservation movement. They are the most conspicuous ambassadors for entire marine ecosystems and possibly even for the biosphere as a whole. Concurrent with our realisation of impending threats to their environment is a growing scientific understanding of the social and cognitive complexity of many of these species. This book brings together experts in the relevant diverse fields of cetacean research to provide authoritative descriptions of our current knowledge of the complex behaviour and social organization of whales and dolphins. The authors consider this new information in the context of how different human cultures from around the world view cetaceans and their protection including attitudes to whaling. They show how new information on issues such as cetacean intelligence, culture and the ability to suffer warrants a significant shift in global perceptions of this group of animals and how these changes might be facilitated to improve conservation and welfare approaches.

This has led to the extirpation of many marine mammal populations and even to the extinction of species. However, in parallel to this destructive drive, since antiquity, humanity has been influenced by a strong fascination for marine mammals which contributes today to an increased human appreciation of the natural world, admixed with widespread concern for its degrading condition. The special status occupied by marine mammals in human imagination and affection stands in stark contrast with the current predicament of many populations still threatened by the doings of *Homo sapiens*, a condition emblematic of the relationship of humanity with nature and key to understanding where humanity is heading.
