systemic cybernetic approach in recent decades The articles in the second section deal in particular with the different methodological approaches developed when confronting real problems from issues that affect humanity as a whole to minor but specific questions arising in human organizations Certain sub themes are discussed by the various authors always from a didactic vantage including problem discovery and diagnosis and development of the respective critical theory the design of ad hoc strategies and methodologies the implementation of both qualitative soft system methodologies and formal and quantitative such as the General System Problem Solver or the axiological operational perspective approaches cross disciplinary integration and suitable methods for broaching psychological cultural and socio political dynamisms.
