Referendum campaign and the 2017 general election The Letter encouraging the British proletariat to greater revolutionary fervour was apparently sent by Grigori Zinoviev head of the Bolshevik propaganda organization to the British Communist Party in September 1924 Sent to London through British Secret Intelligence Service channels it arrived during the general election campaign and was leaked to the press The Letter's publication by the Daily Mail on 25 October 1924 just before the General Election humiliated the first ever British Labour government headed by Ramsay MacDonald when its political opponents used it to create a Red Scare in the media Labour blamed the Letter for its defeat insisting there had been a right wing Establishment conspiracy and many in the Labour Party have never forgotten it The Zinoviev Letter has long been a symbol of political dirty tricks and what we would now call fake news But it is also a gripping historical detective story of spies and secrets fraud and forgery international subversion and the nascent global conflict between communism and capitalism
