McCarty, 2005 The effect of the use of vocabulary word maps on comprehension in a middle school civics and economics classroom was investigated Upon completion of this study research showed that the mean scores of seventh grade middle school students receiving the treatment were minimally higher on a unit assessment Students in the control group and the experimental group were given the same unit assessment at the end of a six week study This assessment included multiple choice and completion items Data were analyzed using a one tail two sample t test The results did not show a significant positive difference in the unit assessment scores of students in the experimental group as compared to students in the control group
