Voices from the Iron House Leo Ou-fan Lee, 1987 Lu Xun formerly also romanized Lu Hs n was the pen name of Zhou Shuren 25 September 1881 19 October 1936 a leading figure of modern Chinese literature Writing in Vernacular Chinese as well as Classical Chinese Lu Xun was a short story writer editor translator literary critic essayist and poet In the 1930s he became the titular head of the League of Left Wing Writers in Shanghai Wikipedia *Voices from the Iron House* Leo Ou-fan Lee, 1987 *Poe's Pervasive Influence* Barbara Cantalupo, 2012-10-05 The essays in this collection were originally presented as talks at the Poe Studies Association's Third International Edgar Allan Poe Conference The Bicentennial in October 2009 All the essays in this volume deal with Poe's influence on authors from the United States and abroad in addition the collection also includes two examples of primary texts by contemporary authors whose work is directly related to Poe's work or life an interview with Japanese detective novelist Kiyoshi Kasai and poems by Charles Cantalupo This volume includes interpretative essays on international authors whose work reflects back on Poe's work Edogawa Rampo from Japan Lu Xun from China Fernando Pessoa E a de Queir's and Ramalho Ortig o from Portugal Angela Carter from England and Nikolai Gogol from Russia The essays in this collection complement and extend a project begun by Lois Vines Poe Abroad University of Iowa Press 1999 and take a wider perspective on Poe's influence with essays on Poe's impact on American authors William Faulkner Mary Oliver Joyce Carol Oates Nathaniel Hawthorne Herman Melville and Harriet Jacobs **Literary Authority and the Modern Chinese Writer** Wendy Larson, 1991 Throughout the twentieth century Chinese writers have confronted the problem of creating a new literary tradition that both maintains the culturally unique aspects of a rich heritage and succeeds in promoting a new modernity In the first book length treatment of the topic Wendy Larson examines the contradictory forms of authority at work in the autobiographical texts of modern Chinese writers and scholars and the way these conflicts helped to shape and determine the manner in which writers viewed themselves their texts and their work Larson focuses on the most famous writers associated with the May Fourth Movement a group most active in the 1920s and 1930s and their fundamental ambivalence about writing She analyzes how their writing paradoxically characterized textual labor as passive negative and inferior to material labor and the more physical political work of social progress and she describes the ways they used textual means to devalue literary labor The impact of China's increasing contact with the West particularly the ways in which Western notions of individualism and democracy influenced Chinese ideologies of self and work is considered Larson also studies the changes in China's social structure notably those linked to the abolition in 1905 of the educational exam system which subsequently broke the link between the mastery of certain texts and the attainment of political power further denigrating the cultural role of the writer **Whither Class?** Xueping Zhong, 2025-02-24 This book argues that the revolutionary anti-revolutionary counter-revolutionary and post-revolutionary dialectics in modern Chinese history since the early 20th century characterizes modern and contemporary Chinese literature the most Central to these

dialectics are issues of class The book contends that one cannot fully understand modern and contemporary Chinese literature without understanding the class character of Chinese revolutionary and counter revolutionary struggles including literary practices and their various contradictions Considering literature via the notion of the event and focusing on three specific historical junctures this project explores how as a major cultural form literature has played an outsize role in China's struggle for liberation and quest for modernity It highlights the need to understand class and the extent to which it shapes literary and artistic forms and expressions as well as the on going debates over the relationship between politics and aesthetics

Mapping Modern Beijing Weijie Song, 2018 Mapping Modern Beijing investigates the five methods of representing Beijing a warped hometown a city of snapshots and manners an aesthetic city an imperial capital in comparative and cross cultural perspective and a displaced city on the Sinophone and diasporic postmemory by authors travelling across mainland China Taiwan Hong Kong and overseas Sinophone and non Chinese communities The metamorphosis of Beijing's everyday spaces and the structural transformation of private and public emotions unfold Manchu writer Lao She's Beijing complex about a warped native city Zhang Henshui's popular snapshots of fleeting shocks and everlasting sorrows illustrate his affective mapping of urban transition and human manners in Republican Beijing Female poet and architect Lin Huiyin captures an aesthetic and picturesque city vis vis the political and ideological urban planning The imagined imperial capital constructed in bilingual transcultural and comparative works by Lin Yutang Princess Der Ling and Victor Segalen highlights the pleasures and pitfalls of collecting local knowledge and presenting Orientalist and Cosmopolitan visions In the shadow of World Wars and Cold War a multilayered displaced Beijing appears in the Sinophone postmemory by diasporic Beijing native Liang Shiqiu Taiwan sojourners Zhong Lihe and Lin Haiyin and migr martial arts novelist Jin Yong in Hong Kong Weijie Song situates Beijing in a larger context of modern Chinese language urban imaginations and charts the emotional topography of the city against the backdrop of the downfall of the Manchu Empire the rise of modern nation state the 1949 great divide and the formation of Cold War and globalizing world Drawing from literary canons to exotic narratives from modernist poetry to chivalric fantasy from popular culture to urban planning Song explores the complex nexus of urban spaces archives of emotions and literary topography of Beijing in its long journey from imperial capital to Republican city and to socialist metropolis
