While there were hundreds of such kidnappings he was among the few who were freed from such slavery Twelve Years a Slave 1853 sub title Narrative of Solomon Northup citizen of New York kidnapped in Washington city in 1841 and rescued in 1853 from a cotton plantation near the Red River in Louisiana is a memoir by Solomon Northup as told to and edited by David Wilson It is a slave narrative of a black man who was born free in New York state but kidnapped in Washington D C sold into slavery and kept in bondage for 12 years in Louisiana He provided details of slave markets in Washington D C and New Orleans as well as describing at length cotton and sugar cultivation on major plantations in Louisiana The work was published soon after Harriet Beecher Stowe s novel about slavery Uncle Tom s Cabin 1852 to which it gave factual support Northup s book of 1853 sold 30 000 copies and was considered a bestseller After being published in several editions in the 19th century the book fell into obscurity for nearly 100 years until it was re discovered on separate occasions by two Louisiana historians Sue Eakin Louisiana State University at Alexandria and Joseph Logsdon University of New Orleans In the early 1960s they researched and retraced Solomon Northup s journey and co edited a historically annotated version that was published by LSU Press in 1968 More recently a critically acclaimed feature film 12 Years a Slave 2013 directed by Steve McQueen and starring Chiwetel Ejiofor as Solomon Northup was released

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
