1. Proven CV benefit means it has label indication of reducing CV events for GLP-1 RA (strongest evidence for semaglutide + empagliflozin + canagliflozin) whereas the SGLT2i evidence extends stronger for empagliflozin + canagliflozin.

2. Be aware that SGLT2i vary by region and individual agent with regard to indicated level of eGFR for initiation and continued use.

3. Both empagliflozin and canagliflozin have shown reduction in HF and reduction in CV progression in CVOs.

4. Repaglinide or glimepiride have demonstrated CV safety.

5. Low dose may be better tolerated through less well studied for CV effects.

6. Choose later generation SI with lower risk of hypoglycaemia.

7. Semaglutide / glimepiride OR glimepiride / TZD / detemir + SPP-4i insulin.

8. Semaglutide + empagliflozin + canagliflozin + metformin + lisinopril.

9. If no specific contraindications (i.e. no established CV, low risk of hypoglycaemia and lower priority to avoid weight gain or no weight related contraindications).

10. Consider country- and region-specific cost of drugs. In some countries TZDs relatively more expensive and SPP-4i relatively cheaper.
