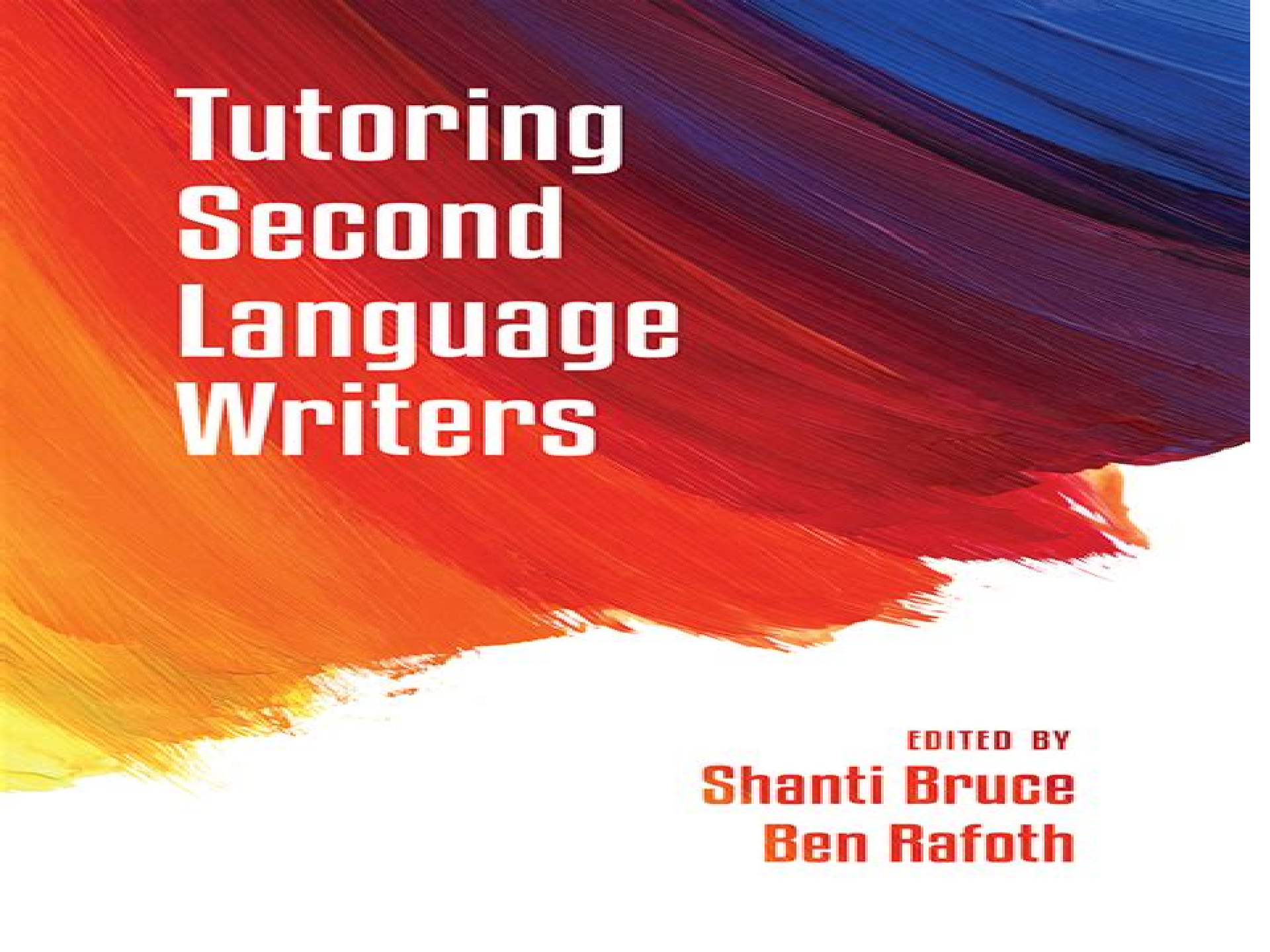

Tutoring Second Language Writers Shanti Bruce, Ben Rafoth, 2016-03-01 Tutoring Second Language Writers a complete update of Bruce and Rafoth's 2009 *ESL Writers* is a guide for writing center tutors that addresses the growing need for tutors who are better prepared to work with the increasingly international population of students seeking guidance at the writing center. Drawing upon philosopher John Dewey's belief in reflective thinking as a way to help build new knowledge, the book is divided into four parts. Part 1, *Actions and Identities*, is about creating a proactive stance toward language difference, thinking critically about labels, and the mixed feelings students may have about learning English. Part 2, *Research Opportunities*, demonstrates writing center research projects and illustrates methods tutors can use to investigate their questions about writing center work. Part 3, *Words and Passages*, offers four personal stories of inquiry and discovery, and Part 4, *Academic Expectations*, describes some of the challenges tutors face when they try to help writers meet readers' specific expectations. Advancing the conversations tutors have with one another and their directors about tutoring second language writers and writing, *Tutoring Second Language Writers* engages readers with current ideas and issues that highlight the excitement and challenge of working with those who speak English as a second or additional language. Internationalizing the Writing Center Noreen Groover Lape, 2020-03-10 Internationalizing the Writing Center provides a rationale pedagogical plan and administrative method for developing a multilingual writing center The book incorporates work from writing center studies as well as second language acquisition studies including English as a second language English as a foreign language second language writing and foreign language writing Author Noreen Lape draws on ten years of experience directing a multilingual writing center that offers writing tutoring in eleven languages and she incorporates the voices and insights of foreign language writing tutors and faculty from surveys interviews and tutoring session reports Lape begins by exploring the dominance of English medium writing centers in a globalized world and arguing for the expansion of English centric into multilingual writing centers She then considers how tutor training differs when the writing center is multilingual as opposed to monolingual and the writing is second language and foreign language as well as native language The chapters on tutor training explore issues such as holistic tutoring composing in a foreign language the role of translating in the writing process

creating a positive learning environment and developing intercultural competence In multiple appendices Lape shares original exercises that writing center administrators can use to train foreign language writing tutors The book ends with a discussion of strategies for engaging faculty and administrators as stakeholders and collaborating with those stakeholders to create a sustainable center

Robillard, 2008 The recent cases of Doris Kearns Goodwin and Kaavya Viswanathan demonstrate that plagiarism is a hot button issue It is also pervasive occurring in universities four year colleges community colleges and secondary schools In graduate programs international classrooms and

multicultural classrooms In writing centers and writing across the curriculum programs In scholarly publications and the popular media How do we understand a literacy practice that is simultaneously so abhorred and so present in the lives of both beginning and advanced writers students and Pulitzer Prize winners Pluralizing Plagiarism offers multiple answers to this question answers that insist on taking into account the rhetorical situations in which plagiarism occurs While most scholarly publications on plagiarism mirror mass media s attempts to reduce the issue to simple black and white statements the contributors to Pluralizing Plagiarism recognize that it takes place not in universalized realms of good and bad but in specific contexts in which students cultural backgrounds often play a role Teachers concerned about plagiarism can best address the issue in the classroom especially the first year composition classroom as part of writing pedagogy and not just as a matter for punishment and prohibition Pluralizing Plagiarism opens a productive dialogue about what is at stake in plagiarism one that approaches the topic with students rather than for or about them Leading the way toward curricular reform its contributors take student work seriously and therefore encourage teachers to take student writing and learning seriously

Contending with Language Difference in the Writing Center Amanda Presswood, 2022 Laura Greenfield and Karen Rowen argue that in order to realize the change potential within tutor education writing center directors must look critically at how we have been designing and executing our tutor education courses This dissertation addresses the call to examine the additional factors on which tutor education can be structured or restructured and what ideologies about language and specifically second language use inhibit writing center administrators ability to decouple tutor training from the unidirectional monolingualistic ideals that have historically been at the center of writing instruction As one site of both language instruction and writing support writing centers are an optimal space to analyze the assumptions that administrators and tutors bring to working with multilingual students The writing center tutor education course is often where tutors learn the tacit theories that tell them what is right or normal in the writing center I followed Johanek s 2000 lead in adopting an epistemologically mixed approach to this study By epistemologically mixed I mean it accounts for multiple ways of knowing This study uses CDA as its methodological grounding because it takes into account the social act of knowing and enables a researcher to analyze linguistic and semiotic details in light of larger social and political or in the case of my study institutional contexts Huckin et al 2012 describes critical discourse analysis as an interdisciplinary approach to textual study that aims to explicate abuses of power promoted by those texts by analyzing linguistic semiotic details in light of the larger social and political contexts in which those texts circulate pages 107 Because I examined the attitudes and expectations about second language writing through the use of interviews it was essential that this research was grounded in a methodology that accounts for both the context and theory This study has three key findings a writing Center Administrators who had experience in either linguistics or TESOL took a more second language studies approach while those that had little or no formal preparation in TESOL or linguistics took a more translingual approach to working on language diversity b when

writing center administrators lacked expertise in the very areas that their L2 ESL residential multilingual students need they have a tendency to hook onto the agendas that they can understand and one of the central reasons that writing center administrators are hesitant to train tutors to offer linguistic feedback is because they are afraid of being labeled as racist or not anti racist enough

One on one encounters with writers often contribute more to the development of student writing abilities than any classroom activity because they are personalized and responsive to individual needs For the encounters to be successful the writing tutor teacher or consultant must be prepared must be knowledgeable of what it means to write and the factors that make writing more and less effective and must also know the students This guide focuses on what those who conference with second language writers need to know to respond best to students recognize their needs and steer conversations in productive directions One on One with Second Language Writers provides tips about activities that can be adapted to individual contexts student writing samples that can be analyzed for practice a glossary a list of useful resources and a checklist for conferencing sessions The book is appropriate for use in university and secondary school writing or learning centers teacher training programs for both general composition and ESOL instructors and as an individual reference tool The book uses non technical language where possible but terminology is introduced where it might be useful when conferencing with students

Teaching Writing as a Second Language Alice Horning, 1987 Addressing basic writing not only as a practical problem and humane responsibility but also as a challenging area for research and theorizing this book reviews interprets and applies the growing body of work in second language acquisition Chapter 1 presents 6 hypotheses constituting an attempt to develop a cohesive theory of writing acquisition that incorporates the redundancy of language and facilitates the process of language acquisition The following chapters explore this theory in detail to serve as a basis for experimental confirmation Chapters 2 and 3 on spoken and written language and redundancy provide the theoretical basis for the argument that academic discourse is a separate linguistic system characterized by particular psycholinguistic features Chapters 4 and 5 present a detailed analysis of the behavior of basic writers with respect to written form reviewing both pertinent second language theory about learners errors and a case study of one writer Chapters 6 and 7 discuss the relevant affective factors analyzed in second language acquisition theory and detail Stephen Krashen s recent proposals for a comprehensive theory of second language acquisition The final chapter reviews the entire theory summarizes the evidence and outlines the agenda for further research JD
