It deals with the theory of function spaces of type s, s, B and F as it stands at the beginning of this century. These two scales of p, q, p, q spaces cover many well known spaces of functions and distributions such as Hölder, Zygmund spaces, fractional and classical Sobolev spaces, Besov spaces, and Hardy spaces. On the one hand, this book is essentially self-contained. On the other hand, we concentrate principally on those developments in recent times which are related to the nowadays numerous applications of function spaces to some neighboring areas such as numerics, signal processing, and fractal analysis, to mention only a few of them. Chapter 1 in Tri is a self-contained, historically oriented survey of the function spaces considered and their roots up to the beginning of the 1990s, entitled "How to measure smoothness." Chapter 1 of the present book has the same heading, indicating continuity. As far as the history is concerned, we will now be very brief, restricting ourselves to the essentials needed to make this book self-contained and readable. Teichmüller in the 1930s. It is a basic tool in the study of Riemann's moduli spaces and the mapping class groups. These objects are fundamental in several fields of mathematics, including algebraic geometry, number theory, topology, geometry, and dynamics. The original setting of Teichmüller theory is complex analysis. The work of Thurston in the 1970s brought techniques of hyperbolic geometry to the study of Teichmüller space and its asymptotic geometry. Teichmüller spaces are also studied from the point of view of the representation theory of the fundamental group of the surface in a Lie group G , most notably $G = \mathrm{PSL}(2, \mathbb{R})$ and $G = \mathrm{PSL}(2, \mathbb{C})$. The current research interests include the quantization of
