The Pentecostal Gender Paradox Joseph Lee Dutko, 2023-11-16 The distinct subjects of eschatology and gender equality have seen an explosion of interest in recent decades particularly within Pentecostal scholarship Pentecostalism is regarded ideally as both an eschatological and egalitarian movement However many Pentecostals have lamented the inconsistency between the early egalitarian impulse of the movement and its current restrictive practices This situation has been described as the so called Pentecostal gender paradox referring to the conflicting freedoms and limitations experienced by Pentecostal women Pentecostals have also recognized the waning eschatological fervor within the movement and its shifting eschatological convictions leading to calls to rediscover the eschatological heart of the movement Despite the renewed interest in both eschatology and women s equality little research has been done to put these two areas into conversation with each other eschatological convictions are often absent in the debate on gender roles in the church For Pentecostals eschatology has often been about urgency in saving souls rather than attending to social issues but could Pentecostal eschatology be the key to re discovering greater equality for women in the church Is the waning of both eschatology and women s equality within Pentecostalism potentially interrelated For over one hundred years the role of women in Pentecostalism has been debated without a firm consensus By examining gender solely through an eschatological lens in history Scripture and praxis this work provides a valuable and creative contribution to one of the most important theological and global issues of our time women s in equality This book is also one of the first comprehensive studies to approach a single social issue solely through an eschatological lens and to provide attention to developing a thorough and methodologically connected eschatological praxis By uncovering the unified eschatological egalitarian narrative thread within both the Pentecostal and biblical story this work suggests that the present end of women s inequality begins with fidelity to the future eschaton of gender equality

Mission as Integrated Witness Jae-Suk Lee, 2021-05-25 This study aims to read Jesus's foot washing narrative missionally John 13:1-38 A missional reading is identical to a missional hermeneutics based on the literary theological interpretation of the text John uses sending language and formulae and the frame of as so throughout the whole Gospel which clarifies Jesus's and his disciples mission as integrated witness In this literary context the foot washing narrative signifies the integrated witness of Jesus and the disciples The narrative consists of two parts one Jesus's symbolic action for his death and the other for its interpretation for the disciple community Jesus's death as his unique mission results in

Neo-Pentecostalism Nelson Kalombo Ngoy, 2019-05-23 For centuries Pentecostalism has played a significant role in oppressively shaping the life of formerly colonized people of Africa. Moreover its theologies have perpetuated neocolonial policies developed through the lens of colonial legacies rooted in the mission civilizatrice mission to civilize. However since the 1980s Neo-Pentecostalism is increasingly reshaping the Congolese Christendom. It sanctions the theologies of a prosperity gospel rooted in an uncritical reading of the Bible and self-theologizing informed by a lack of literal contextual translation effects. This book argues that the prosperity gospel bankrupts its adherents in this case the vulnerable impoverished sections of Sub-Saharan Africa and particularly the Postcolonial Congo and instead offers a balanced theological reflection that broadens Neo-Pentecostal studies with an African voice encouraging the rewriting and rereading of the story of redemptive mission. The research engages a paradigm shift within global missions and world Christianity or the history of missions as the platform to negotiate literal prophetic and contextual translation and retransmission of the biblical gospel. It is critical to reclaim and reestablish a hermeneutic of mixed methodologies and construct a contextual and critical interpretation of the Bible in the Congo. To avoid the African assumption of cultural baggage which affects how the Congolese interpret the Bible the interpreter has to be neutral and experience the voice of Christ in the text instead of the voice of Congolese culture they must be a prophetic voice to reconstruct the authentic meaning of the salvific story. **American Missionaries, Korean**
