Shakespeare and Accentism Adele Lee, 2020-12-28 This collection explores the consequences of accentism an under researched issue that intersects with racism and classism in the Shakespeare industry across languages and cultures past and present It adopts a transmedia and transhistorical approach to a subject that has been dominated by the study of Original Pronunciation Yet the OP project avoids linguistically foreign characters such as Othello because of the additional complications their aberrant speech poses to the reconstruction process It also evades discussion of contemporary global practices and underpinning the enterprise is the search for an aural purity that arguably never existed By contrast this collection attends to foreign speech patterns in both the early modern and post modern periods including Indian East Asian and South African and explores how accents operate as metasigns reinforcing ethno racial stereotypes and social hierarchies It embraces new methodologies which includes reorienting attention away from the visual and onto the aural dimensions of performance

Wallace Stevens and Pre-Socratic Philosophy Daniel Tompsett, 2012-09-10 This book studies Wallace Stevens and pre Socratic philosophy showing how concepts that animate Stevens poetry parallel concepts and techniques found in the poetic works of Parmenides Empedocles and Xenophanes and in the fragments of Heraclitus Tompsett traces the transition of pre Socratic ideas into poetry and philosophy of the post Kantian period assessing the impact that the mythologies associated with pre Socratism have had on structures of metaphysical thought that are still found in poetry and philosophy today This transition is treated as becoming increasingly important as poetic and philosophic forms have progressively taken on the existential burden of our post theological age Tompsett argues that Stevens poetry attempts to play its audience into an ontological ground in an effort to show that his reduction of metaphysics is not dry philosophical imposition but is enacted by our encounter with the poems themselves Through an analysis of the language and form of Stevens poems Tompsett uncovers the mythology his poetry shares with certain pre Socratics and with Greek tragedy This shows how such mythic rhythms are apparent within the work of Friedrich Nietzsche Martin Heidegger and Hans Georg Gadamer and how these rhythms release a poetic understanding of the violence of a reduction of metaphysics

Teaching Human Rights in Literary and

Cultural Studies Alexandra Schultheis Moore, Elizabeth Swanson Goldberg, 2015-11-01 Since the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of 1948 the discourse of human rights has expanded to include not just civil and political rights but economic social cultural and most recently collective rights Given their broad scope human rights issues are useful touchstones in the humanities classroom and benefit from an interdisciplinary and cross cultural pedagogy in which objects of study are situated in historical legal philosophical literary and rhetorical contexts Teaching Human Rights in Literary and Cultural Studies is a sourcebook of inventive approaches and best practices for teachers looking to make human rights the focus of their undergraduate and graduate courses Contributors first explore what it means to be human and conceptual issues such as law and the state Next they approach human rights and related social justice issues from the perspectives of particular geographic regions and historical eras through the lens of genre and in relation to specific rights violations for example storytelling and testimonio in Latin America or poetry created in the aftermath of the Armenian genocide Essays then describe efforts to cultivate students capacity for ethical reading practices and to deepen their understanding of the stakes and artistic dimensions of human rights representations drawing on active learning and experimental class contexts The final section on resources directs readers to further readings in history criticism theory and literary and visual studies and provides a chronology of human rights legal documents

Resistance to Science in Contemporary American Poetry Bryan Walpert, 2011-09-26 This book examines types of resistance in contemporary poetry to the authority of scientific knowledge tracing the source of these resistances to both their literary precedents and the scientific zeitgeists that helped to produce them Walpert argues that contemporary poetry offers a palimpsest of resistance using as case studies the poets Alison Hawthorne Deming Pattiann Rogers Albert Goldbarth and Joan Retallack to trace the recapitulation of romantic arguments inherited from Keats Shelly and Coleridge which in turn were produced in part in response to Newtonian physics modernist arguments inherited from Eliot and Pound arguments influenced in part by relativity and quantum theory and postmodernist arguments arguments informed by post structuralist theory e g Barthes Derrida Foucault with affinities to arguments for the limitations of science in the philosophy sociology and rhetoric of science Some of these poems reveal the discursive ideologies of scientific language reveal in other words the performativity of scientific language In doing so these poems themselves can also be read as performative acts and therefore as forms of intervention rather than representation Reading Retallack alongside science studies scholar Karen Barad the book concludes by proposing that viewing knowledge as a form of intervention rather than representation offers a bridge between contemporary poetry and science

Mobile Narratives Eleftheria Arapoglou, Mónika Fodor, Jopi Nyman, 2013-08-15 Emphasizing the role of travel and migration in the performance and transformation of identity this volume addresses representations of travel mobility and migration in 19th 21st century travel writing literature and media texts In so doing the book analyses the role of the various cultural ethnic gender and national encounters pertinent to narratives of travel and migration in transforming and problematizing the

identities of both the travelers and travelees enacting in the borderzones between cultures While the individual essays by scholars from a wide range of countries deal with a variety of case studies from various historical spatial and cultural locations they share a strong central interest in the ways in which the narratives of travel contribute to the imagining of ethnic encounters and how they have acted as sites of transformation and transculturation from the early nineteenth century to the present day In addition to discussing textual representations of travel and migration the volume also addresses the ways in which cultural texts themselves travel and are reconstructed in various cultural settings The analyses are particularly attentive to the issues of globalization and migration which provide a general frame for interpretation What distinguishes the volume from existing books is its concern with travel and migration as ways of forging transcultural identities that are able to subvert existing categorizations and binary models of identity formation In so doing it pays particular attention to the performance of identity in various spaces of cultural encounter ranging from North America to the East of Europe putting particular emphasis on the representation of intercultural and ethnic encounters

The Right to Difference Nicole Coleman, 2021-10-14 The Right to Difference examines novels that depict human rights violations in order to explore causes of intergroup violence within diverse societies using Germany as a test case In these texts the book shows that an exaggeration of difference between minority and majority groups leads to violence Germany has become

increasingly diverse over the past decades due to skilled labor migration and refugee movements In light of this diversity this book's approach transcends a divide between migrant and post migrant German literature on the one hand and a national literature on the other hand Addressing competing definitions of national identity as well as the contest between cultural homogeneity and diversity the author redefines the term intercultural literature It becomes not a synonym for authors who do not belong to a national literature such as migrant writers but a way of reading literature with an intercultural lens This book builds a theory of intercultural literature that focuses on the multifaceted nature of identity in which ethnicity represents only one of many characteristics defining individuals To develop intercultural competence one needs to adopt a complex image of individuals that allows for commonalities and differences by complicating the notion of sharp contrasts between groups Revealing the affective allegiances formed around other characteristics gender profession personal motivations relationships and more allows for similarities that grouping into large homogeneous and seemingly exclusive entities conceals Eight novels analyzed in this book remember and reveal human rights violations such as genocide internment and torture violent expulsion the reasons for fleeing a country dangerous flight routes and the difficulty of settling in a new country Some of these novels allow for affective identification with diverse characters and cast the protagonists as individuals with plural perspectives and identities rather than monolithic members of one large national or ethnic group whereas others emphasize the commonalities of all people Ultimately the author makes the case for German Studies to contribute to an antiracist approach to diversity by redefining what it means to be German and establishing difference as a fundamental human right
