terms of freedom as non domination the intrinsic value of democratic participation through deliberative democracy and community This can be contrasted with the rights based individualism and State neutrality characteristic of the liberal approach Despite the promise of civic community in the Third Way rhetoric this book demonstrates that the reality of New Labour's experiment in union recognition was an emphatic reassertion of liberalism in the sphere of workers collective rights This is the first monograph to offer a sustained critical analysis of legal approaches to trade union recognition It will be of particular interest to labour lawyers but also a wider audience of scholars in political philosophy and industrial relations
