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 the group of notables who in the middle of the last century made the little Massachusetts town of Concord their home and
 who thus conferred on it a literary fame both unique and enduring Thoreau is the only one who was Concord born His
 neighbor Emerson had sought the place in mature life for rural retirement and after it became his chosen retreat Hawthorne
 Alcott and the others followed but Thoreau the most peculiar genius of them all was native to the soil Hawthorne Alcott His
 book was the result of several journeys but the only trip of which he tells us in detail was in October That month therefore
 was the one I chose for my own visit to the Cape when I went to secure the series of pictures that illustrate this edition for I
 wished to see the region as nearly as possible in the same guise that Thoreau describes it From Sandwich where his record of
