fee based specialized disability programs on first year student experiences and perceptions of campus climate This study contributes to the understanding of the conditions that support and challenge the higher education experiences of first year students with disabilities. The findings also highlight a need for more research examining a broader range of disability categories and the intersection of disability and race.
