Virtual Reality Melanie Chan, 2014-01-16 The idea of virtual realities has a long and complex historical trajectory spanning from Plato's concept of the cave and the simulacrum to artistic styles such as Trompe L'oeil and more recently developments in 3D film television and gaming However this book will pay particular attention to the time between the 1980s to the 1990s when virtual reality and cyberspace were represented particularly in fiction as a wondrous technology that enabled transcendence from the limitations of physical embodiment The purpose of this critical historical analysis of representations of virtual reality is to examine how they might deny repress or overlook embodied experience Specifically the author will contend that embodiment is a fundamental aspect of immersion in virtual reality rather than something which is to be transcended In this way the book aims to challenge distorted ideas about transcendence and productively contribute to debates about embodiment and technology

The Other Side of Empathy Jade E. Davis, 2023-06-30 In *The Other Side of Empathy* Jade E. Davis contests the value of empathy as an affective or critical tool Whether focusing on technology colonialism or racism she shows how empathy can obscure relationships of dominance control submission and victimization arguing that these histories taint the whole concept of empathy Drawing on digital archives of photographs memoirs newspapers interviews and advertisements regarding nineteenth century ethnographic museums and human zoos Davis shows how empathetic responses erase culpabilities from those institutions that commodify difference She also contends that empathy's mediation through digital technology cannot lead to more ethical actions as technology only connects representations of people rather than the people themselves In empathy's place Davis proposes mutual recognition as a way to see and experience others beyond colonial modes of empathy Davis illustrates that moving beyond empathy allows for a more nuanced understanding of the colonial past and its ongoing impact while providing for a more meaningful affective engagement with the world

Letters, Postcards, Email Esther Milne, 2012-02-27 In this original study Milne moves between close readings of letters postcards and emails and investigations of the material technological infrastructures of these forms to answer the question How does presence function as an aesthetic and rhetorical strategy within networked communication practices As her work reveals the relation between old and new communication systems is more complex than allowed in much contemporary media theory Although the correspondents of letters postcards and emails are not usually present to one another as they write and read their exchanges this does not necessarily inhibit affective communication Indeed this study demonstrates how physical absence may in some instances provide correspondents with intense intimacy and a spiritual almost telepathic sense

of the other's presence. While corresponding by letter, postcard or email, readers construe an imaginary incorporeal body for their correspondents that in turn reworks their interlocutor's self-presentation. In this regard, the fantasy of presence reveals a key paradox of cultural communication: namely, that material signifiers can be used to produce the experience of incorporeal presence.
