# Molecular Epidemiology of Measles Virus in Kenya

Measles causes significant morbidity and mortality globally. Many countries have embarked on immunization programs to control and prevent measles outbreaks and eventually to eliminate endemic measles. Kenya is currently in the outbreak control and prevention stage for measles. Measles virus genotyping is important for molecular epidemiological purposes, including the documentation of the elimination of endemic measles virus strains from a country, and mapping of transmission pathways. In this study, we collected clinical specimens from measles outbreak cases in 2002 in Kenya for measles virus genotyping. Wewere able to isolate and/or detect measles virus in 10 cases from 5 of the 8 provinces in Kenya. All these Kenyan measles strains were determined to be genotype D4 strains when compared to the standard World Health Organization-designated measles virus reference strains. Interestingly, the Kenyan D4 strains clustered into two distinct D4 subgroups. In addition, the inclusion of other published D4 measles strains in this analysis indicated that there are four distinct D4 clusterings, or subgroups: Montreal-like, India-like, Johannesburg-like, and Ethiopia-like. This is the first measles molecular epidemiology study in Kenya and establishes the current endemic measles strain as genotype D4. importantly, this study shows that the Kenyan D4 strains are distinct from the B3 measles strain found in West Africa and the D4 strains reported in Ethiopia. #### INTRODUCTION

Measles is an illness characterized by fever and maculopapular rash, as well as coryza, conjunctivitis, and/or cough. Secondary bacterial pneumonia, which can be a cause of mortality in malnourished children, and acute postinfectious encephalitis are both serious complications of measles infections. The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates that there were more than 30 million measles cases, resulting in 777,000 deaths in the year 2000 [World Health Organization, 2002]. The Global Measles Strategic Plan, co-sponsored by the WHO and UNICEF, aims to reduce measles mortality by half by 2005, and to interrupt measles transmission in whole regions [World Health Organization, 2002]. Many countries have implemented measles vaccination programs and are working toward the elimination of measles virus.

The Kenya Expanded Program on Immunization (KEPD was established as a unit within the Ministry of Health in 1980 with the goal of immunizing all children in the country against the six traditional vaccine preventable diseases: tuberculosis, polio, diphtheria, perbussis, tetanus, and measles. Before the establishment of KEPI, immunization in Kenya was given only in some municipalities (Lema, 1975). Even with the availability of immunization, measles epidemics still occurred in urban areas, and mainly affected children younger than 5 years of age [Hayden, 1974; Muller et al., 1977; Wanyama, 2002]. Kenya started routine single-dose measles vaccinations in children at 9 months of age, throughout the country in 1980, at the inception of KEPI. Measles vaccine coverage was 43% countrywide before 1980, 70% in 1987, and approximately 79% in 1998 [Bjerregaard, 1989; Central Bareau of Statistics, 1998).
