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Virgil Aeneid Ix Cambridge Greek And Latin Classics:

Communication, Love, and Death in Homer and Virgil Stephen Ridd, 2017-08-24 Homer's Iliad and Odyssey and Virgil's Aeneid are three of the most important and influential works of Western classical literature. Although they differ in subject matter and authorship, these epic poems share a common purpose: to tell the deeds both of men and of the gods. Written in an accessible style and ideally suited for classroom use, *Communication, Love, and Death in Homer and Virgil* offers a unique comparative analysis of these classic works. As author Stephen Ridd explains, the common themes of communication, love, and death respond to deeply ingrained human needs and are therefore of perennial interest. Presenting select passages from the original Greek and Latin texts translated here into modern English, Ridd explores in detail how the characters within the poems communicate on these subjects with one another as well as with the reader. Individual chapters focus on subjects such as the traditions of singing and storytelling, relationships between sons and mothers, the role of Helen of Troy and her ties to the men in her life, and communication with the dead. Throughout his analysis, Ridd treats the three poems on an equal basis, revealing similarities and differences in their handling of prevalent themes. By introducing readers to a new way of reading these abiding classics, *Communication, Love, and Death in Homer and Virgil* enhances our appreciation of the imaginative world of ancient Greek and Roman epic poetry.

These explorations of enumerative modes, however, have not yet had the impact on classical scholarship that they deserve. While they routinely take a limited set of ancient models as their starting point, there is no comparably comprehensive study that focuses on antiquity. Conversely, studies on lists and catalogues in Classics remain largely limited to individual texts and, with some notable exceptions, offer little in terms of explicit theorising. The present volume is an attempt to close this gap and foster the dialogue between the recent theoretical reappraisal of enumerative modes and scholarship on ancient cultures. The 16 contributions to the volume juxtapose literary forms of enumeration with an abundance of ancient non-sub or para-literary practices of listing and cataloguing. In their different approaches to this vast and heterogeneous corpus, they offer a sense of the hermeneutic, epistemic, and methodological challenges with which the study of enumeration is faced and elucidate how pragmatics, materiality, performativity, and aesthetics are mediated in lists and catalogues.

While Rome Burned Virginia M. Closs, 2020-05-06 *While Rome Burned* attends to the intersection of fire, city, and emperor in ancient Rome, tracing the critical role that urban conflagration played as both reality and metaphor in the politics and literature of the early imperial period. Urban fires presented a consistent problem for emperors from Augustus to Hadrian, especially given the expectation that the princeps be both a protector and provider for Rome's population. The

problem manifested itself differently for each leader and each sought to address it in distinctive ways This history can be traced most precisely in Roman literature as authors addressed successive moments of political crisis through dialectical engagement with prior incendiary catastrophes in Rome's historical past and cultural repertoire Working in the increasingly repressive environment of the early principate Roman authors frequently employed figured speech and mythopoetic narratives to address politically risky topics In response to shifting political and social realities the literature of the early imperial period reimagines and reanimates not just historical fires but also archetypal and mythic representations of conflagration Throughout the author engages critically with the growing subfield of disaster studies as well as with theoretical approaches to language allusion and cultural memory

Flavian Epic Interactions Gesine Manuwald, Astrid Voigt, 2013-08-29 This volume on the three Flavian epic poets Valerius Flaccus Statius and Silius Italicus for the first time critically engages with a unique set up in Roman literary history the survival of four epic poems from the same period *Argonautica* *Thebaid* *Achilleid* *Punica* The interactions of these poems with each other and their contemporary context are explored by over 20 experts and emerging scholars Topics studied include the political dimension of the epics their use of epic themes and techniques and their intertextual relationship among each other and to predecessors The recent upsurge of interest in Flavian epic has been focussed on the analysis of individual works Looking at these poems together now allows the appreciation of their similarities and nuanced differences in the light of their shared position in literary and political history and gives insights into the literary culture of the period The different approaches and backgrounds of the contributors ensure the presentation of a range of viewpoints Together they offer new perspectives to the still increasing readership of Flavian epic poetry but also to anyone interested in the epic genre within Roman literature or other cultures more generally
