here are many reasons why the treatment of borderline patients is difficult. I will explore two of them in this chapter. First, these patients are unable to understand their own psychic functioning and the reasons for others' behaviours due to their lack of an emotional–receptive capacity. Second, since they come from a traumatic environment, they are particularly susceptible to frustrations and react violently to conflict, attempting vindictive revenge against the objects they clash with. This is why borderline patients often perpetuate a very tenacious bond with their traumatising primary objects, from which they cannot separate.

As is known, the term "borderline" was first used to define a psychopathological syndrome halfway between neurosis and psychosis, characterised by a group of symptoms that belonged to both nosographic categories but which implied potential psychotic development concealed behind a neurotic façade.
