These themes include basic characteristics of wetlands, key environmental factors that produce wetland community types, and some unifying problems such as assembly rules, restoration, and conservation. The volume draws upon a complete range of wetland habitats and geographic regions, including Californian vernal pools, Amazonian floodplains, and Russian peat bogs. No other book provides ecological syntheses over the entire geographical and habitat range of wetlands, making *Wetland Ecology* essential reading for anyone planning research or management in wetland habitats regardless of specific area of interest.
