

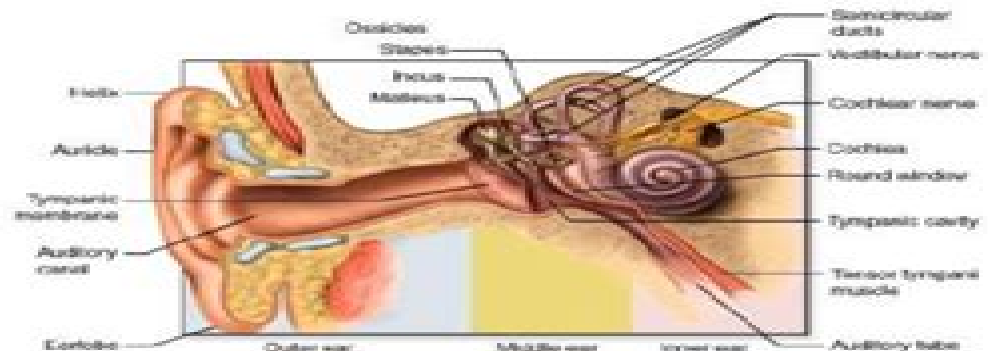
Special senses (hearing and equilibrium)

- Hearing is the ability to perceive sounds
- Human ear is divided into three main regions;

- I. External ear
- II. Middle ear
- III. Inner ear

External ear

- Collects sound waves and channels them inwards
- Consists of the auricle, the external auditory canal and ear drum



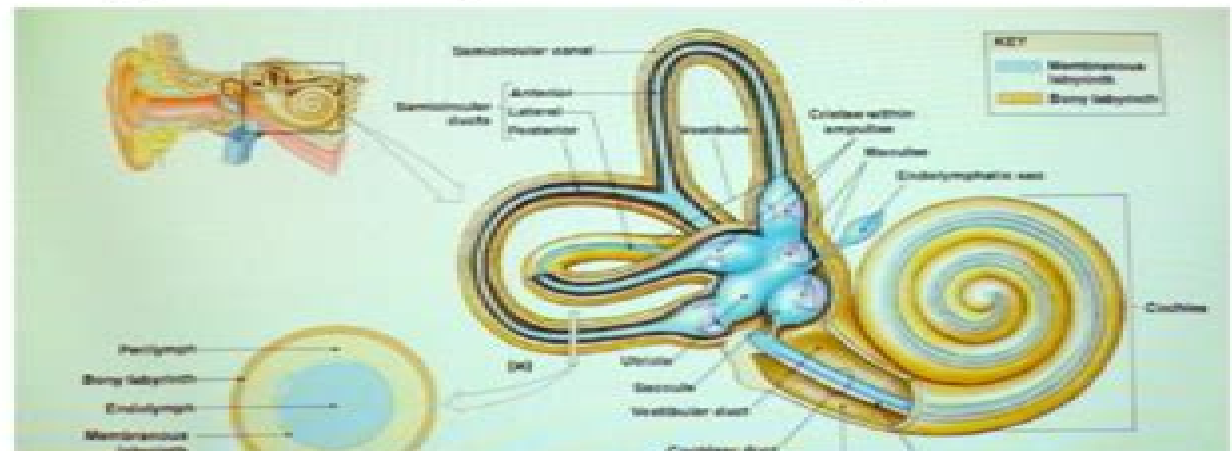
Middle ear

- Conveys sound vibrations to the oval window
- Consists of the malleus, incus, and stapes commonly known as the hammer, anvil and stirrup respectively

Special senses (hearing and equilibrium)

Internal ear

- Also called the labyrinth
- Structurally consists of two main division:
 - I. An outer bony labyrinth
 - II. an inner membranous labyrinth
