From a Nietzschean perspective it is possible to illuminate the film's extraordinary cruelty. Despite appearances George's restoration is temporary at best and there is every reason to believe that eventually he will try to take his life again. Tragically George must leave Bedford Falls and those who love him must insist that he go.
