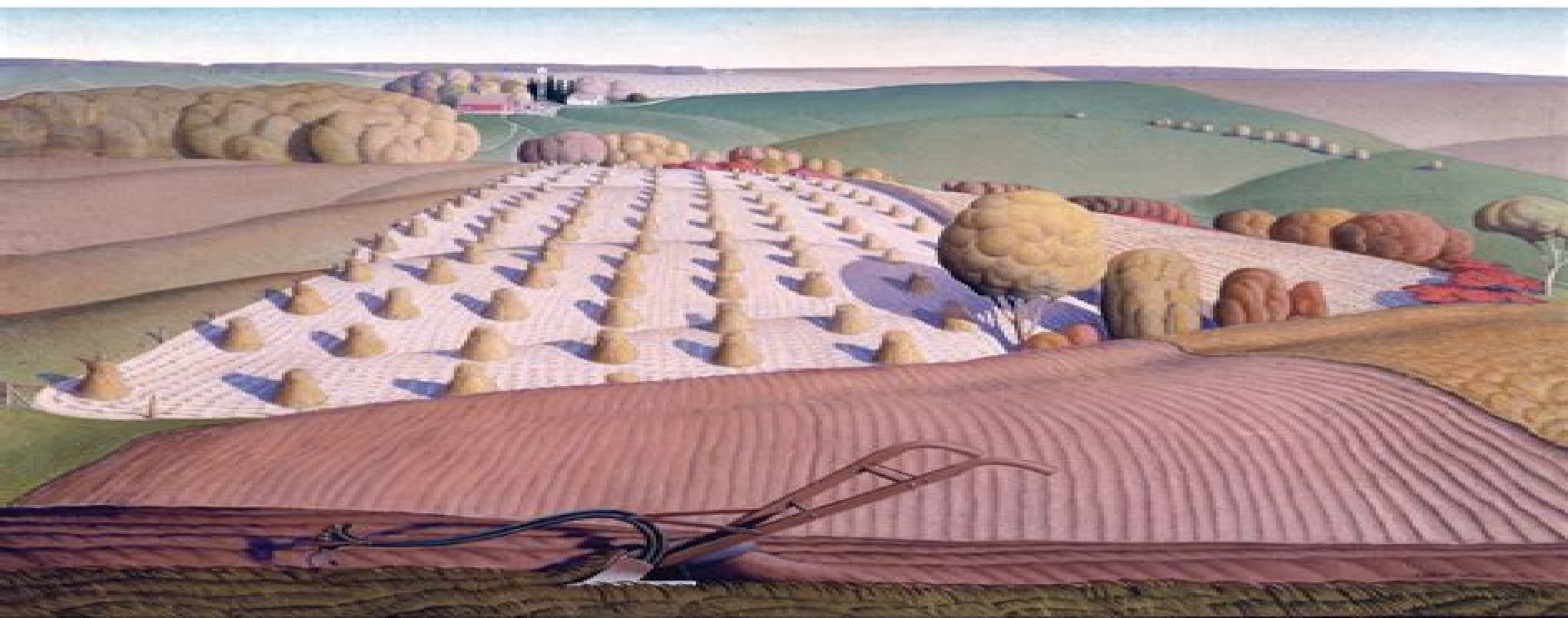

Iowa Historic Property Study Jennifer A. Price, Leah D. Rogers, 2012 The Iowana Farms Milk Company factory building was considered to retain sufficient integrity and possess sufficient significance to be considered eligible for the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A and C for its historical and architectural significance in the Bettendorf community The Iowana Farms Milk Company was an important early to mid twentieth century business in Bettendorf and was among the few that was not owned or operated by the Bettendorf Company It was a strong and thriving business for many years and its products were well known in the Quad Cities region The importance of this property becomes even more significant when one considers that most of the buildings once associated with the actual Bettendorf Company which was undeniably the most important business and industry in town are now gone As a result the Iowana Farms Milk Company factory building was a physical vestige of the once thriving commercial industries that made Bettendorf into a city in the twentieth century This property was further significant for its representation of the evolution of the dairy industry in the twentieth century from farm to factory production It also reflected the changes to the industry based on scientific discoveries mechanical innovations and governmental regulations related to

improved sanitation and the pure milk movement The Iowana Farms Milk Company represented a model plant for the time and the marketing strategies it employed followed the trends of the industry The Iowana Farms Milk Company plant had to be removed to make room for a new I 74 bridge over the Mississippi River at Bettendorf The construction of the new bridge also required removal of the historic Iowa Illinois Memorial Bridge The documentation reported herein and for that of the Iowa Illinois Memorial Bridge fulfills the requirements of the Memorandum of Agreement regarding the removal of these historic properties

Iowa History Reader Marvin Bergman, 2008-03-15 In 1978 historian Joseph Wall wrote that Iowa was still seeking to assert its own identity It has no real center where the elite of either power wealth or culture may congregate Iowa in short is middle America In this collection of well written and accessible essays originally published in 1996 seventeen of the Hawkeye State's most accomplished historians reflect upon the dramatic and not so dramatic shifts in the middle land's history in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries Marvin Bergman has drawn upon his years of editing the Annals of Iowa to gather contributors who cross disciplines model the craft of writing a historical essay cover more than one significant topic and above all interpret history rather than recite it In his preface to this new printing he calls attention to publications that begin to fill the gaps noted in the 1996 edition Rather than survey the basic facts the essayists engage readers in the actual making of Iowa's history by trying to understand the meaning of its past By providing comprehensive accounts of topics in Iowa history that embrace the broader historiographical issues in American history such as the nature of Progressivism and Populism the debate over whether women's expanded roles in wartime carried over to postwar periods and the place of quantification in history the essayists contribute substantially to debates at the national level at the same time that they interpret Iowa's distinctive culture

and 1940s Editor Michael C Steiner has assembled a group of distinguished scholars who explore the lives and works of sixteen progressive western intellectuals authors and artists ranging from nationally prominent figures such as John Steinbeck and Carey McWilliams to equally influential though less well known figures such as Angie Debo and Amrico Paredes Although they never constituted a unified movement complete with manifestos or specific goals the thinkers and leaders examined in this volume raised voices of protest against racial environmental and working class injustices during the Depression era that reverberate in the twenty first century Sharing a deep affection for their native and adopted places within the West these individuals felt a strong sense of avoidable and remediable wrong done to the land and the people who lived upon it motivating them to seek the root causes of social problems and demand change Regionalists on the Left shows also that this radical regionalism in the West often took urban working class and multicultural forms Other books have dealt with western regionalism in general but this volume is unique in its focus on left leaning regionalists including such lesser known writers as B A Botkin Carlos Bulosan Sanora Babb and Joe Jones Tracing the relationship between politics and place across the West Regionalists on the Left highlights a significant but neglected strain of western thought and expression
