Lambshead Before Interwoven Frances Mayhugh Holden, 1982 The history of Lambshead Ranch which is located in Throckmorton and Shackelford counties Texas The Lambshead Ranch area was occupied by several persons including Randolph March Robert Neighbors and Jesse Stem an Indian agent who established an Indian agency there Stem was killed by Indians and his wife oversaw expansion of the ranch The ranch is named for Thomas Lambshead born in 1805 in England who emigrated to Texas around 1847 Thomas bought land in the nearby Round Mountain Creek area Whether Thomas ever lived on Lambshead is not known John A Matthews located on Lambshead in 1897 and brought his family to the ranch in 1915

Turning the Pages of Texas Lonn Taylor, 2019-04-18 Turning the Pages of Texas is a collection of sixty essays about Texas books authors book collectors libraries and bookstores It is a book for booklovers and bookish readers Lonn Taylor writes from the point of view of a historian who has been reading books about Texas for seventy years since he was seven years old and who has known many of the authors he writes about He presents his reflections about well known figures such as John Graves J Frank Dobie and Larry McMurtry He also introduces readers to people like folklorist C L Sonnichsen who wrote about Texas feuds Julia Lee Sinks who interviewed early settlers of Fayette County in the 1870s Karen Olsson who wrote a fine novel about the mystique of Austin and David Dorado Romo who describes himself as the psycho-geographer of El Paso and is the grandnephew of a saint Some of the authors Taylor writes about are truly obscure like Gertrude Beasley who published her

autobiography in Paris in 1924 and died in a New York insane asylum or Tony Cano whose self published autobiographical novel describes what it was like to be poor and Mexican in West Texas in the 1950s Taylor also teases out the Texas connections of writers as diverse as William Sydney Porter Hervey Allen and H Allen Smith and he writes about tracking down Texas books in London and Washington DC as well as at Barber s in Fort Worth the Brick Row Book Shop in Austin and Rosengren s and Brock s in San Antonio This is a booklover s book Interwoven Sallie Reynolds Matthews,1982 Records one woman s response to pioneer life in Texas at the turn of the century T.E.B.: Doctoring in an Age of Scientific Medicine Alan L. At the Heart of Texas Richard B. McCaslin,2014-04-01 History like that of Texas is rare Is it not discreditable to the people of Texas that they should leave the collection of material for the history of the State to the great endowed Northern libraries Let Texas arouse herself for very shame and begin at once the discharge of her filial duty So wrote George Pierce Garrison in the first issue of the Quarterly of the Texas State Historical Association published in July 1897 just months after the establishment of the organization on March 2 The state of Texas was just half a century old the city of Austin going back to the days of the Republic was a little older a few years past its half century and the University of Texas where Garrison was the history professor was not yet fourteen Earlier attempts to organize historical societies in Texas traced in the opening chapter illuminate the factors that came ultimately to be decisive in the success of the Association the wisdom in linking the organization with the University of Texas the inclusion of lay historians and the continued insistence on high academic standards And from the beginning the Association has established a tradition for publishing in the Quarterly in addition to the Anglo story the stories of the Indians the Spanish and the French According to author Richard B McCaslin It may be that the Association survived where its predecessors had not because Garrison who was as much a Progressive historian as any of his contemporaries understood the value of inclusiveness The text is organized in chronological chapters by the tenures of the seven directors George Garrison to Ron Tyler all of whom were professors in the UT history department Within the larger framework of the directors the programs and the publications McCaslin gives shape to the unique interaction of forces university political and the academic lay membership that has accorded the Association a character and suppleness that continues to ensure its long endurance The book is profusely illustrated and sidebars culled from past issues of the Quarterly complement the text Winner of the Award of Merit from the Philosophical Society of Texas **Texas Almanac 2020-2021**
