Even the dependability of the best of today's so far is praiseworthy when one considers the complexity of the functionality provided. Solid engineering and the increasing adoption of methods based on firmly established theory are to be thanked here. Large and complex things are understood as assemblages of simpler components; the way these components fit together is the structure of the system. Structure can be real and physical or a subjective mental tool for analysis.
