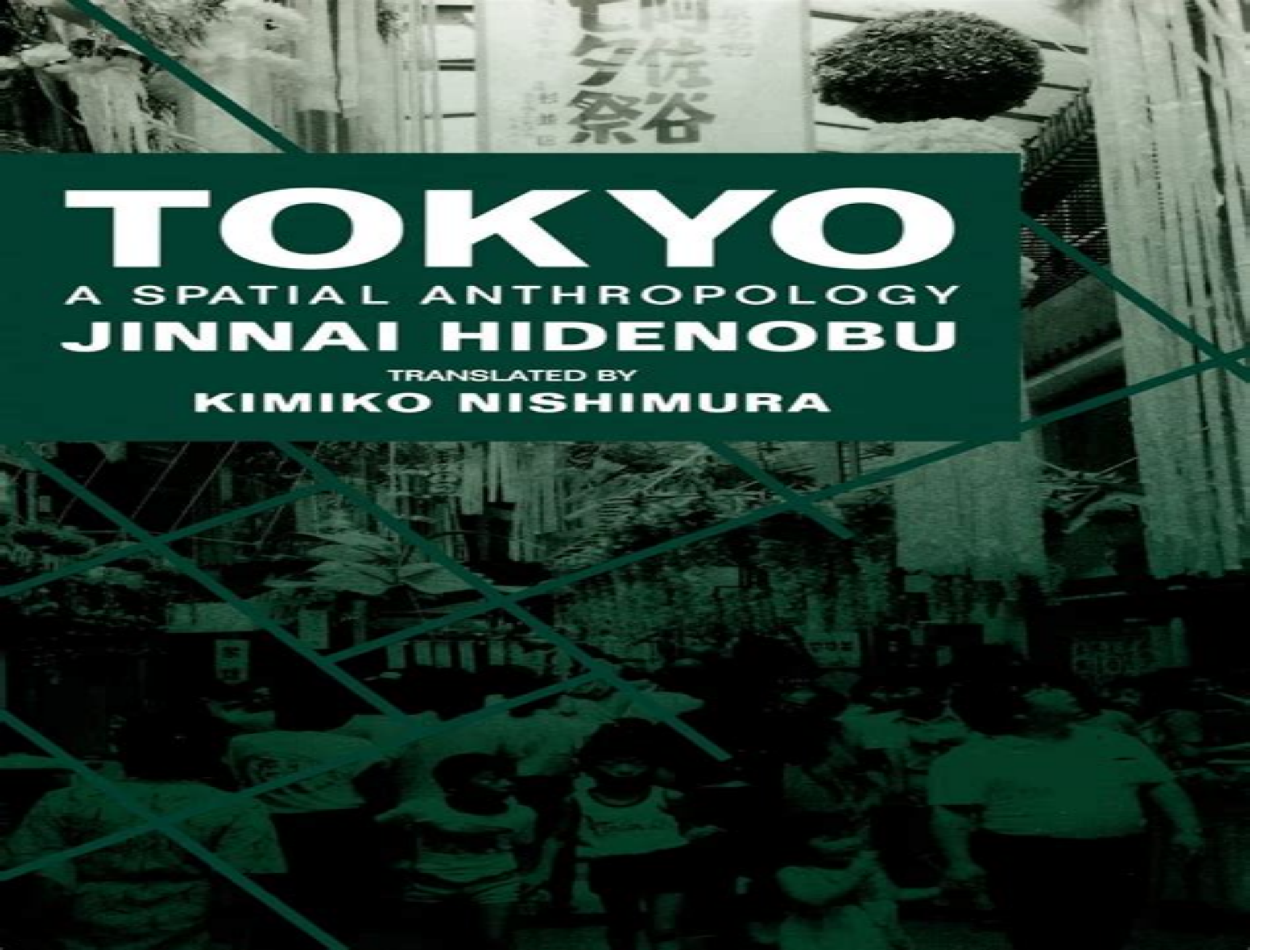

Tokyo Hidenobu Jinnai, 1995 The sheer physical extent of Tokyo its mile upon mile of high density and mostly low rise development seemingly without topographic or maritime memory makes it a difficult city for many Westerners to understand We suspect that the same may be so for many Japanese Jinnai Hidenobu shows us how today s Tokyo is rooted in its early development and how today s streets waterways land uses and building types come from a past that remains visible to those who would care to look One needs to walk or to row with Jinnai to see how yesterday makes today His is a work of love that ties generations together in their physical environment Allan B Jacobs author of *Great Streets* Function-Based Spatiality and the Development of Korean Communities in Japan David Rands, 2014-05-21 Function Based Spatiality and the Development of Korean Communities in Japan utilizes the theoretical model of complex adaptive systems and introduces the concept of function based spatiality to investigate the roles of the urban environments of Tokyo and Osaka in the development of Korean communities in Japan Analysis of distinct Korean communities allows for the examination of urban factors of each city which contributed to the patterns of Korean immigration and community formation By utilizing a comparative narrative of the two cities distinctions between the organic growth of Osaka and the planned city of Tokyo are illuminated Additionally the discussion utilizes the concept of function based spatiality to show how each city interacted with its surrounding regional national and global spheres The functions of Tokyo as a gateway to Western modernization and center of the Japanese state shaped the interactions with Korean immigrants Likewise Osaka s functions as a center of mercantilism and second city played a large role in how Koreans were incorporated into the urban ethnoscaapes Taken together these two examples provide insight to the dynamics of urban systems on the development of immigrant communities

Topographies of Japanese Modernism Seiji M. Doing Ethnography in the Wake of the Displacement of Transnational Sex Workers in Yokohama reflects on the politics poetics and ethics of remembering the lives of transnational migrant sex workers in postcolonial Japan Drawing on ethnographic fieldwork in the port city of Yokohama the book focuses on the water trade in the Koganecho neighbourhood where exploitative and stigmatised labour took place involving sexual services performed by migrant women In recent years the city has sought to rebrand Koganecho evicting transnational migrant sex workers who had been integral to postindustrial development and erasing their past presence The author explores Yokohama's memoryscapes in the aftermath of displacement through embodied knowledge engaging her senses and ethics as a colonizer researcher as she navigates the elusive past through traces that remain in the present She examines the city's built environment official historical narratives films and photographic works With few brothels and workers remaining Yoshimizu fills the gap with her own interactions encounters and imaginings Yoshimizu also writes through the imagery of water in ways that are informed by the local usage and imaginations the ocean flowing rivers swamps humidity alcohol the fluidity of relationships and transient lives The water also offers a way to sense the ghost or the displaced lives and the effects of displacement that like humid air stick to those who occupy or inhabit the site of displacement today This interdisciplinary work makes a valuable contribution to sensory studies memory studies migration studies and Asian studies
