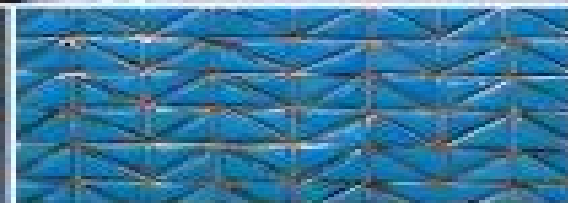
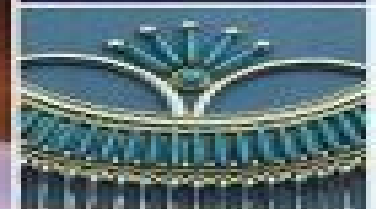

Rodee, Milford Nahohai, 1996 More than a guide to technique and design this insiders view of Zuni silverwork offers a fascinating window into Zuni culture The authors examine Zuni silversmithing as an expression of cultural values and aesthetics and explore the relationships between jewelers and traders They trace the history of jewelry at Zuni since Anasazi times Using examples by more than twenty contemporary Zuni artists they describe the techniques of casting clusterwork petitpoint needlepoint mosaic overlay and inlay for which Zuni jewelry is famous as well as nontraditional styles using new materials and techniques Also included are several interviews in which Zunis discuss the aesthetics and history of silversmithing Published in cooperation with the Maxwell Museum of Anthropology University of New Mexico

The Navajo and Pueblo Silversmiths John Adair, 1944 Probably no Native American handicrafts are more widely admired than Navajo weaving and Navajo and Pueblo silver work This book which is now in its third large printing contains the most important and complete account of Indian jewelry fashioned by the Navajo the Zuni the Hopi and other Pueblo peoples With the care of a meticulous and thorough scholar the author has told the story of his several years investigation of jewelry making among the Southwestern Indians says The Dallas Times Herald So richly decorative are the plates he uses that the conscientious narrative is surrounded by an atmosphere of genuinely exciting visual experience John Adair is a trained ethnologist who has lived and worked among these Indians To prepare his book Mr Adair made an exhaustive examination of the principal museum collections of Navajo and Pueblo silver work both early and modern in Santa Fe Colorado Springs Chicago New York and Philadelphia He visited trading posts in the Indian country and examined and photographed silver on the pawn racks and in important private collections He lived for a time among the Navajo watched them make their jewelry and actually learned to work silver himself in the hogan of one of the leading artisans Tom Burnsides Many of the photographs he made at the time are used as illustrations in this book He spent months among the Indians in New Mexico and Arizona and became personally acquainted with many of their silversmiths Later as field worker for the Indian Arts and Crafts Board he studied the economics of Navajo and Pueblo silversmithing and still later he became manager of the Navajo Arts and Crafts Guild a tribal enterprise The Navajo and Pueblo Silversmiths provides a full history of the craft and the actual names and localities of the pioneer craftsmen who introduced the art of the silversmith to their people Despite its present high stage of development with its many subtle and often exquisite designs the art of working silver is not an ancient one among the Navajo and Pueblo Indians There are men still living today who remember the very first silversmiths Mr Adair gives full details as he observed them of the methods and techniques of manufacture over a primitive forge with homemade tools He tells both of the fine pieces made for trade among the Indians themselves and of the newer cheaper types of jewelry produced for sale to tourists He discusses standards and qualities of Indian silver and describes the work of the Indian schools in helping preserve traditional design in the fine silver of today His excellent

photographs of some of the most notable pieces old and new provide examples for evaluation This volume therefore will serve the layman the ethnologist and the dealer alike as a guide to proper values in Indian silver jewelry and will provide the basis for authoritative knowledge and appreciation of a highly skilled creative art

Seventeenth-Century Metallurgy on the Spanish Colonial Frontier Noah H. Thomas, 2018-11-13 A unique contribution to the archaeological literature on the Southwest Seventeenth Century Metallurgy on the Spanish Colonial Frontier introduces a wealth of data from one of the few known colonial metal production sites in the Southwest Archaeologist Noah H Thomas draws on and summarizes ten seasons of excavation from the Pueblo of Paako to provide a critical analysis of archaeological features and materials related to metal production during the early colonial period AD 1598-1680 Extrapolating from the data Thomas provides a theoretical interpretation of these

data that is grounded in theories of agency practice and notions of value shaped in culture In addition to the critical analysis of archaeological features and materials this work brings to light a little known aspect of the colonial experience the production of metal by indigenous Pueblo people Using the ethnography of Pueblo peoples and seventh century European manuals of metallurgy Thomas addresses how the situated agency of indigenous practitioners incorporated within colonial industries shaped the metallurgy industry in the Spanish colonial period The resulting analysis investigates how economic technical and social knowledge was communicated contested and transformed across the social and cultural boundaries present in early colonial communities Viewing these transformations through an ethnohistorical lens Thomas builds a social and historical context within which to understand the decisions made by colonial actors at the time *Southwest Silver Jewelry* Paula A. Baxter, 2001 This beautiful book examines the first century of Navajo and Pueblo metal jewelry making in the American Southwest Beginning in the late 1860s the region's native peoples learned metalworking and united it with a tradition of beads and ornaments made from turquoise and other natural materials The cross cultural appeal of this jewelry continued into the mid 1900s and by the 1950s and 1960s masters created a legacy of fine art jewelry that is prized today

Johanson, 2011-05-25 The Archaeology of Politics is a collection of essays that examines political action and practice in the past through studies and analyses of material culture from the perspective of anthropological archaeology Contributors to this volume explore a variety of multi-scalar relationships between past peoples places objects and environments At stake in this volume is what it is that constitutes politics its social and cultural location fields of analysis its materiality and sociology and especially its position and possibilities as a conceptual and analytical category in archaeological investigations of past socio-cultural worlds Our primary goals are twofold the problematization and re-conceptualization of politics from its understanding as a reified essence or structure of political forms e.g. a State to a fluid dynamic and culturally inflected set of practices and second to consider politics entanglement with the materiality of socio-cultural worlds at multiple scales through the demonstration of innovative analytical approaches to the material record The volume is a tightly integrated group of essays exploring an assortment of case studies that offer new theoretical insight to archaeological and historical analyses of politics *Extreme Collecting* Graeme Were, J. King, 2012-03-01 By exploring the processes of collecting which challenge the bounds of normally acceptable practice this book debates the practice of collecting difficult objects from a historical and contemporary perspective and discusses the acquisition of objects related to war and genocide and those purchased from the internet as well as considering human remains mass produced objects and illicitly traded antiquities The aim is to apply a critical approach to the rigidity of museums in maintaining essentially nineteenth century ideas of collecting and to move towards identifying priorities for collection policies in museums which are inclusive of acquiring difficult objects Much of the book engages with the question of the limits to the practice of collecting as a means to think through the implementation of new
