The Battery

Installing the battery

 Place your finger in the slot at the bottom of the back cover to lift and remove the cover.



Insert the battery by aligning the metal contacts on the battery with the gold contacts in the battery compartment. Gently push down on the battery until it dicks into place.



3. Press the cover gently back into place until you hear a click.

Removing the battery

- 1. Remove the back cover.
- 2. Lift the battery up and out.

Charging the Battery

 Connect the adapter to the charging port. Ensure that the adapter is inserted with the correct orientation. Do not force the connector into the charging port.



Connect the charger to a standard AC wall outlet. If the phone is on, you'll see a charging icon, such as E or N, appear in the Status Bar.
