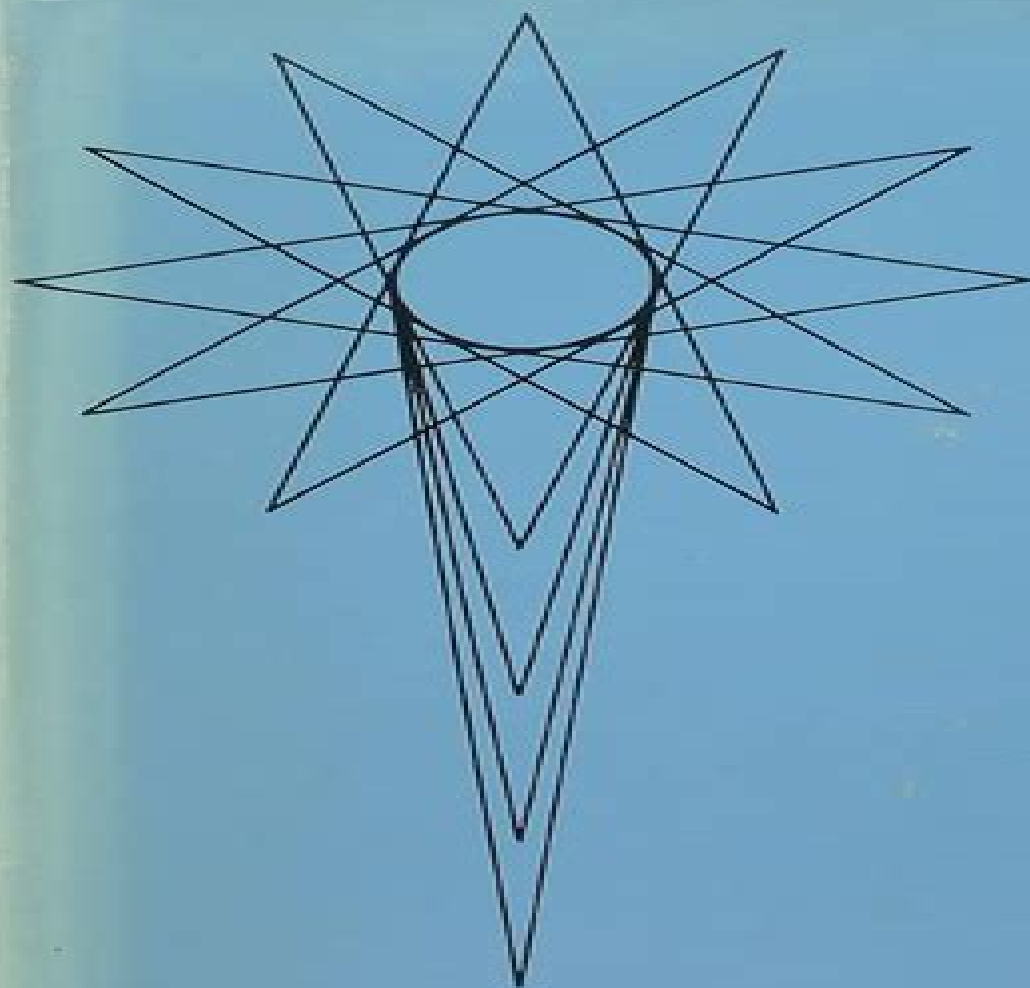

Vision and Blindness in Film Dago Schelin, 2019-02-13 In order to understand vision, we have to look into concepts of blindness both diegetically in typical film characters and in the representation of sight or lack thereof. A critical historical investigation into theories of vision shows that the way we understand visuality today, scientifically and culturally, is very different from pre-modern notions and practices. In this book, Dago Schelin questions categories such as active and passive vision, tactile visuality, as well as blind vision and discusses them alongside a variety of movies that deal with vision and blindness. Is there a connection between the

filmmaker's gaze and an older pre-Keplerian ontology of vision. What is the role of sound in vision? Are our eyes mere camcorders or might they be projectors? These and other questions comprise the fascinating journey on which this study embarks.

Studies on Plotinus and al-Kindi Peter Adamson, 2023-05-31 This book collects 15 papers on the greatest philosopher of late antiquity and founder of Neoplatonism Plotinus d. 270 and the founding figure of philosophy in the Islamic world al-Kindi d. ca. 873. A number of the contributions focus on the text that joins the two: the so-called Theology of Aristotle, in fact an Arabic version of Plotinus' Enneads produced in al-Kindi's translation circle. Across several papers Adamson argues that this translation is best understood as a reinterpretation of Plotinus designed to appeal to contemporary readers in the culture of the Abbasid era. Two contributions also analyze the notes on the Theology written by the great Avicenna. Other papers look at aspects of al-Kindi's own thought, exploring his ideas concerning metaphysics, free will, astrology, and optics. The traditions of Plotinus and al-Kindi are also treated with papers on Plotinus' student Porphyry and his Arabic reception, and on followers of al-Kindi. Adamson argues that we can identify what he calls a Kindian tradition in the 9th–10th centuries. He discusses the philosophical presuppositions of this movement and the use of al-Kindi's ideas made by one particular representative of the Kindian tradition, the Persian thinker Miskawayh.

Jody Enders, University of California, Santa Barbara. *Stumbling Blocks Before the Blind* presents the first comprehensive exploration of a disability in the Middle Ages, drawing on the literature, history, art history, and religious discourse of England and France. It relates current theories of disability to the cultural and institutional constructions of blindness in the eleventh through fifteenth centuries, examining the surprising differences in the treatment of blind people and the responses to blindness in these two countries. The book shows that pernicious attitudes about blindness were partially offset by innovations and ameliorations, social, literary, and to an extent, medical, that began to foster a fuller understanding and acceptance of blindness. A number of practices and institutions in France, both positive and negative, blinding as punishment, the foundation of hospices for the blind, and some medical treatment, resulted in not only attitudes that commodified human sight but also inhumane satire against the blind in French literature, both secular and religious. Anglo-Saxon and later medieval England differed markedly in all three of these areas, and the less prominent position of blind people in society resulted in noticeably fewer cruel representations in literature. This book will interest students of literature, history, art history, and religion, because
