AGING PHYSIOLOGY/PHARMACOLOGY

- Spectrum of aging
 - Usual Aging -> absent of overt pathology but some functional decline
 - Successful Aging → maintain physical/cognitive function with low risk of disease/disability
 - O Homeostenosis → narrowing of ability to maintain balance in the body → gradual loss of reserve function and ability to maintain homeostasis under stress
- Body Composition
 - Lipid compartment expands -> lipophilic drugs, incr fat, so incr toxicity
 - TBW (ECF) declines -> diuretics, less ECF, so need lowest possible dose
 - o Lean muscle mass declines -> digoxin binds to muscles, so decr. efficacy
- DERMATOLOGY
 - Decrease in apocrine and sebaceous gland function decreased antiperspirant/deodorant use (DRY SKIN)
 - Red plaques along infra-mammary folds -> Candida Interigo
 - Longer renewal time for wound healing
 - Thinning of skin
 - o Dry skin is v common
 - Flattened rete ridges (extension of epidermis into dermis) -> prone to skin tears
 - Less responsive to effects of UV light → DECREASED UV light
 - Decreased function and number of eccrine sweat glands → MORE SENSITIVE TO TEMPERATURE
 - Thickened toe nails
- CARDIOLOGY
 - o Resting HR is unchanged with AGE
 - MAXIMUM HR = 220 AGE OR 208 0.7(AGE)
 - Vasculature become stiffer
 - Decreased elastin & increased tunica media thickness -> SET UP FOR ATHEROSCLEROSIS
 - o BP becomes HTN at 140/90: ELDERLY → 150/90 WHEN OLDER THAN 60
 - Measure BP in elderly, sitting at rest for 5 minutes
 - Postural changes → orthostatic stress can occur and predispose for orthostatic hypotension (feeling light-headed and dizzy) → NOT NORMAL
 - Cardiac wall thickness increases with age
 - Cardiac ventricular filling rate decreases with age
 - Elderly become more reliant on atrial kick
