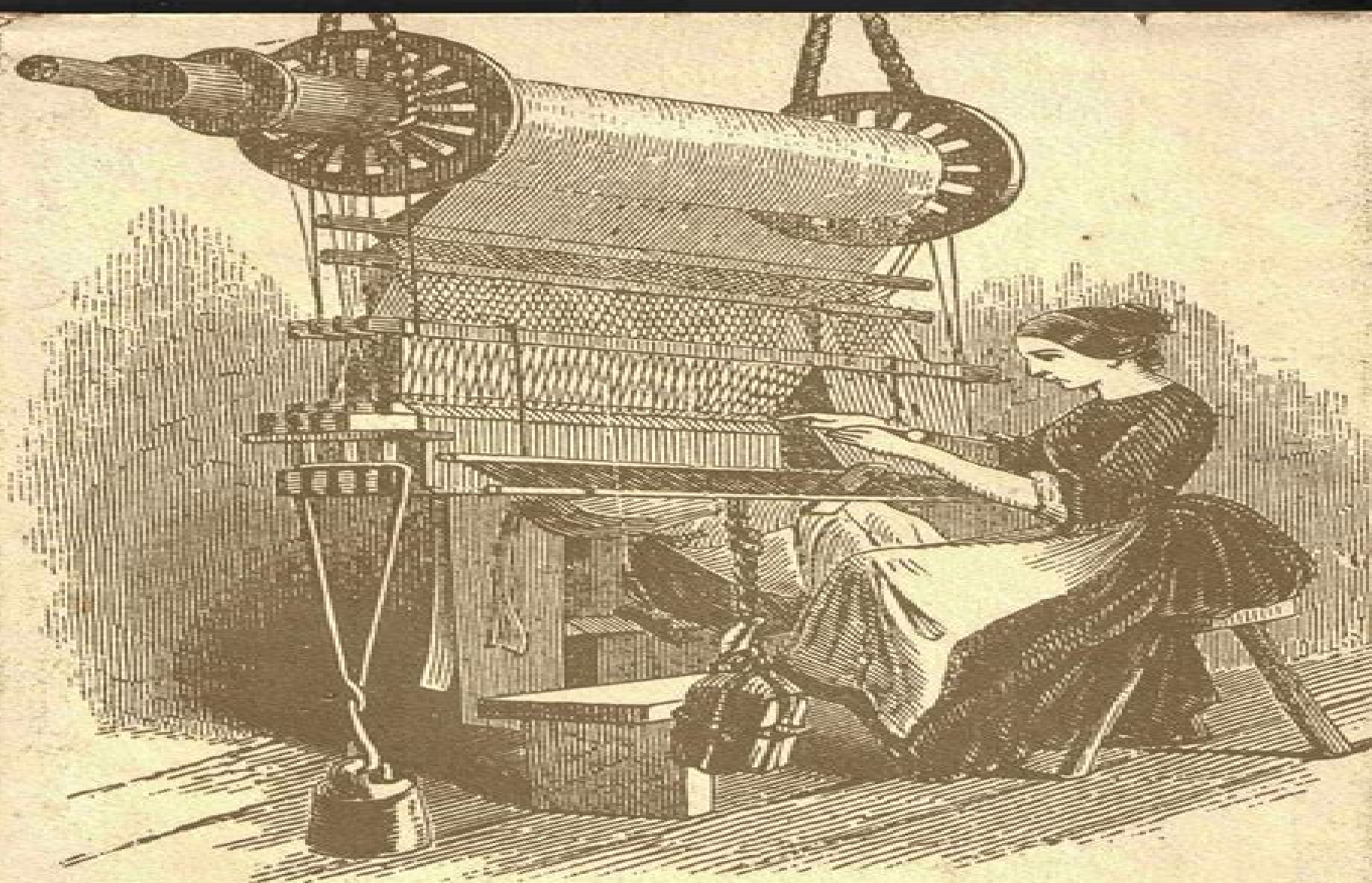

conclusions that challenge a variety of historical concepts including separate spheres of influence for men and women and related economic theories for example that women were passive players in the workplace evolutionary theories with respect to industrial development and business culture within and between the two industries Overall it provides the fresh approach that highlights and explains women s agency as operatives and paid workers during industrialization *Women at Work*

Stowell,1999-06 For one week in late July of 1877 America shook with anger and fear as a variety of urban residents mostly working class attacked railroad property in dozens of towns and cities The Great Strike of 1877 was one of

the largest and most violent urban uprisings in American history Whereas most historians treat the event solely as a massive labor strike that targeted the railroads David O Stowell examines America's predicament more broadly to uncover the roots of this rebellion He studies the urban origins of the Strike in three upstate New York cities Buffalo Albany and Syracuse He finds that locomotives rumbled through crowded urban spaces sending panicked horses and their wagons careening through streets Hundreds of people were killed and injured with appalling regularity The trains also disrupted street traffic and obstructed certain forms of commerce For these reasons Stowell argues The Great Strike was not simply an uprising fueled by disgruntled workers Rather it was a grave reflection of one of the most direct and damaging ways many people experienced the Industrial Revolution Through meticulously crafted case studies the author advances the thesis that the strike had urban roots that in substantial part it represented a community uprising A particular strength of the book is Stowell's description of the horrendous accidents the toll in human life and the continual disruption of craft business and ordinary movement engendered by building railroads into the heart of cities Charles N Glaab *American Historical Review*

Lunardini,2000 A convenient handbook of dates names terms and resources as well as a highly readable overview of the pivotal role of women in a century of profound political and social change The authors emphasize areas in which scholars have identified important changes such as suffrage and reform topics in which researchers are now making great strides such as racial ethnic religious and regional diversity and innovative and relatively recent explorations for example work on female sexuality **Work and Workers** Lee Braude,1983 **The Roots of Rural Capitalism** Christopher Clark,1990 Between the late colonial period and the Civil War the countryside of the American northeast was largely transformed Rural New England changed from a society of independent farmers relatively isolated from international markets into a capitalist economy closely linked to the national market an economy in which much farming and manufacturing output was produced by wage labor Using the Connecticut Valley as an example The Roots of Rural Capitalism demonstrates how this important change came about Christopher Clark joins the active debate on the transition to capitalism with a fresh interpretation that integrates the insights of previous studies with the results of his detailed research Largely rejecting the assumption of recent scholars that economic change can be explained principally in terms of markets he constructs a broader social history of the rural economy and traces the complex interactions of social structure household strategies gender relations and cultural values that propelled the countryside from one economic system to another Above all he shows that people of rural Massachusetts were not passive victims of changes forced upon them but actively created a new economic world as they tried to secure their livelihoods under changing demographic and economic circumstances The emergence of rural capitalism Clark maintains was not the result of a single transition rather it was an accretion of new institutions and practices that occurred over two generations and in two broad chronological phases It is his singular contribution to demonstrate the coexistence of a family based household economy persisting well into the nineteenth century and the market oriented system of production and exchange that is generally held to have emerged full blown by the eighteenth century He is adept at describing the clash of values sustaining both economies and the ways in which the rural household based economy through a process he calls involution ultimately gave way to a new order His analysis of the distinctive role of rural women in this transition constitutes a strong new element in the study of gender as a factor in the economic social and cultural shifts of the period Sophisticated in argument and engaging in presentation this book will be recognized as a major contribution to the history of capitalism and society in nineteenth century America **Harvest of Dissent** Thomas Summerhill,2005 With an
