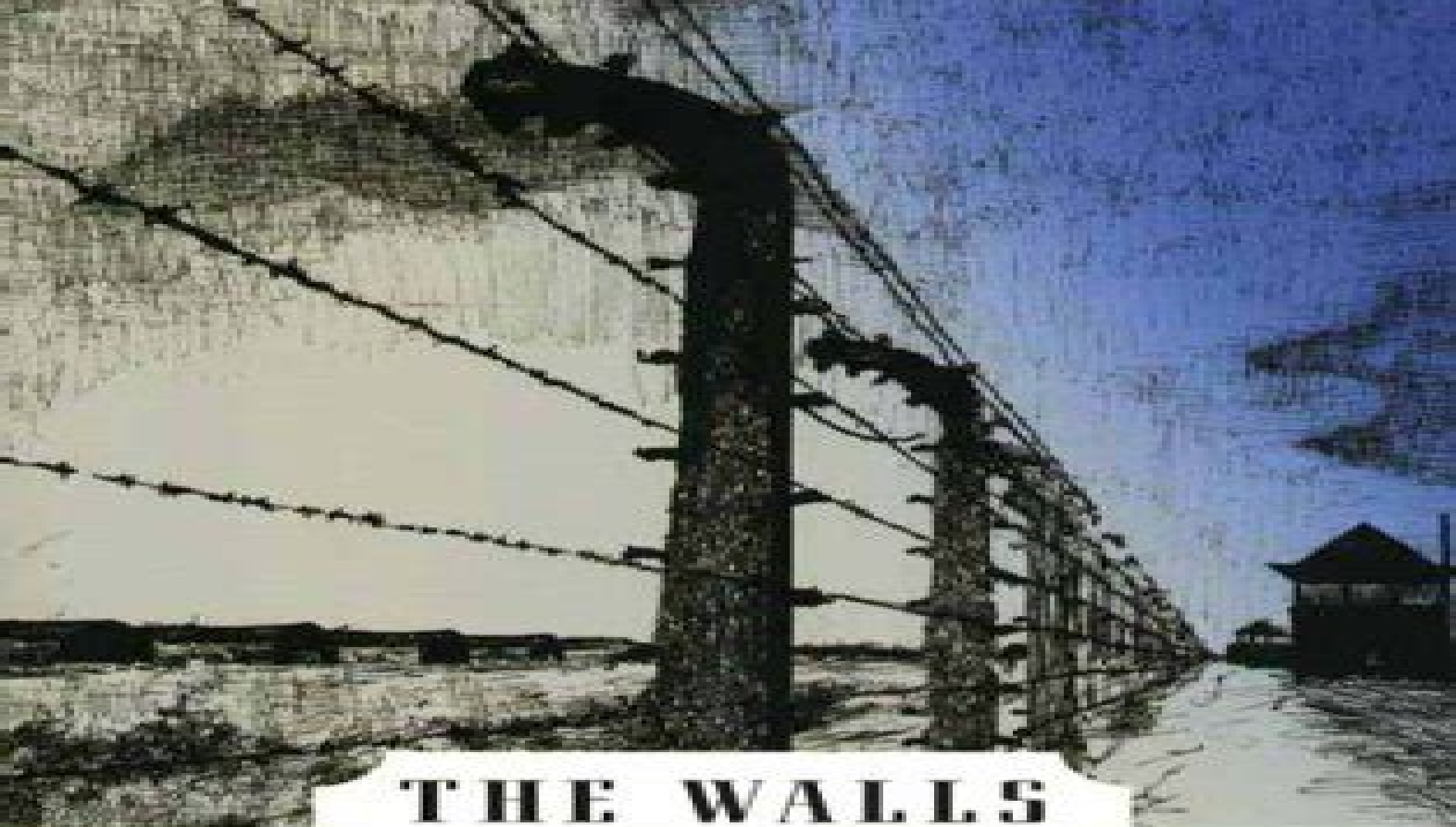

In 1941, Woolf drowned herself in the River Ouse at Lewes, aged 59.
