

intriguing features are his detailed descriptions of the nervous system and its interactions with the muscles to create movement in response to stimulus Though we now know that many of these details are wrong Descartes understanding that much of the body functions as a machine was a stroke of genius He is the first to describe the reflex arc anticipating Pavlov and the behaviorists by almost 300 years The idea of the body as a kind of animal machine that functions according to physical laws was an immense advance over the previous scholastic notions based on Aristotle which merely begged the question of how the various organs of the body work by stating that it is in their nature to perform their specific functions. This is a landmark work that students of history medicine biology and the history of science will find richly rewarding
