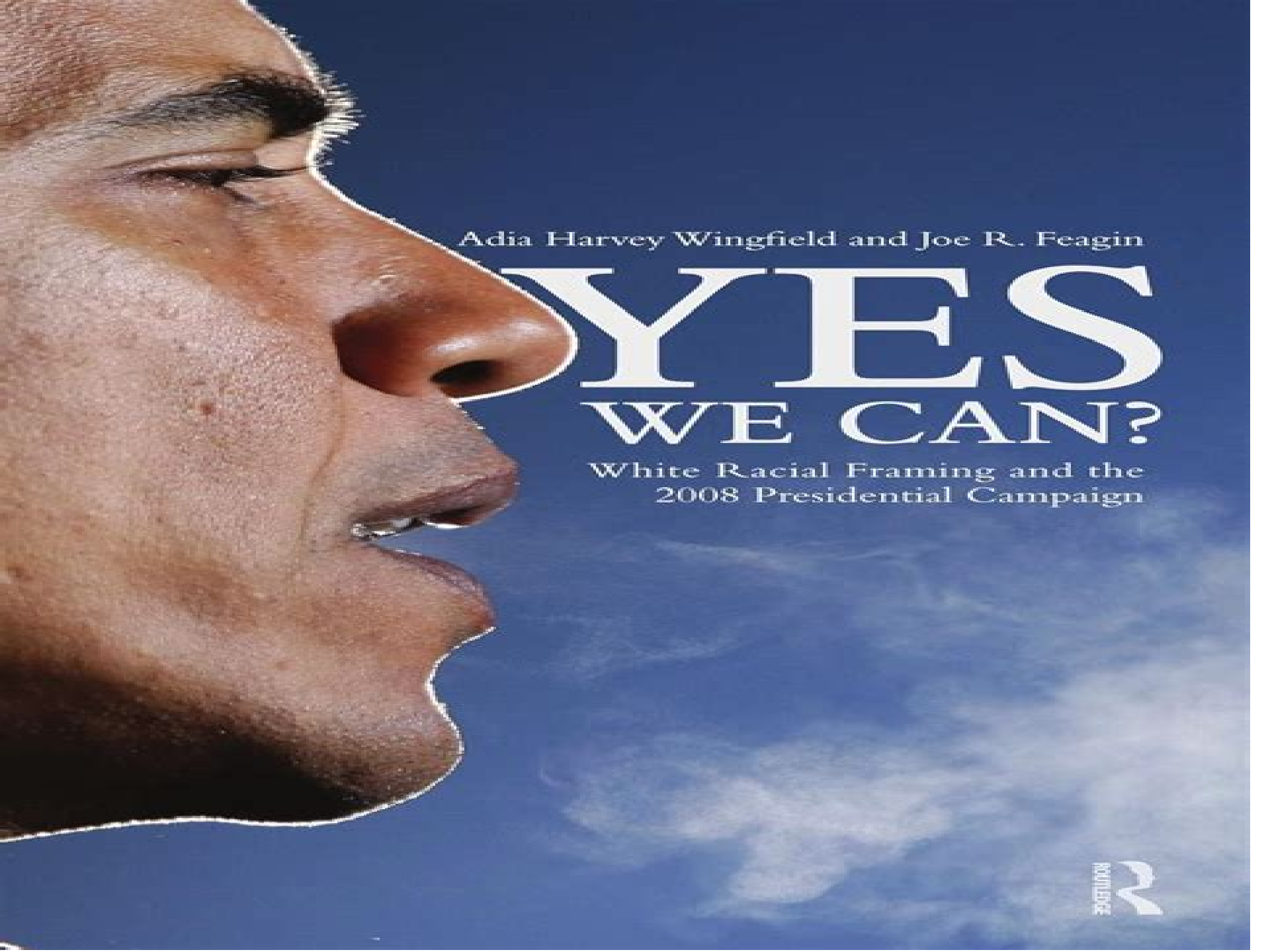




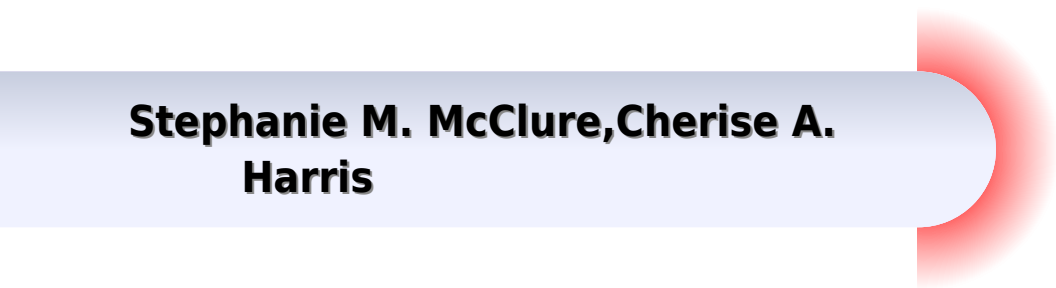

The White Racial Frame Joe R. Feagin, 2013-08-21 In this book, Joe Feagin extends the systemic racism framework in previous Routledge books by developing an innovative concept: the white racial frame.
