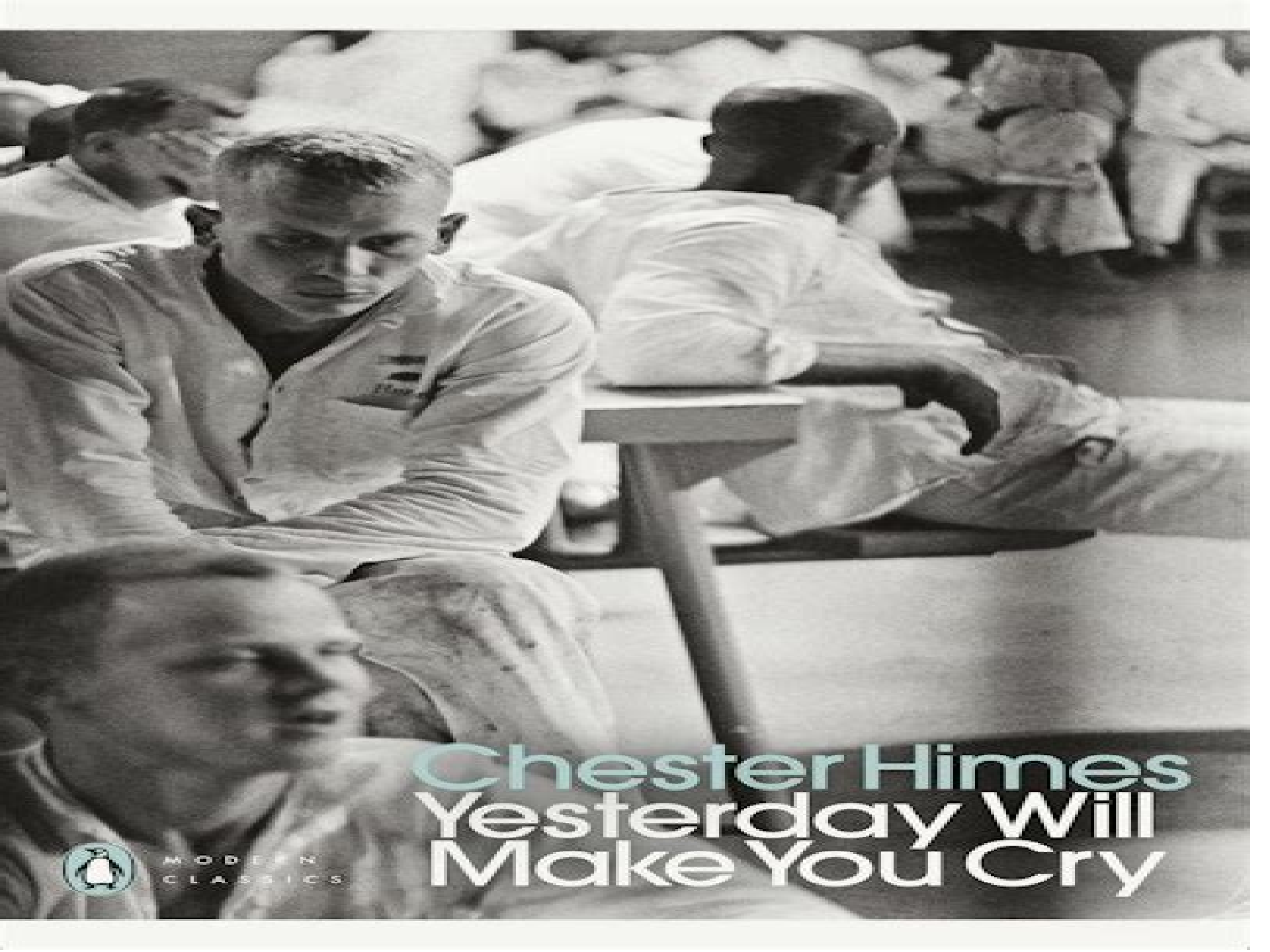

Charles, 2012-12-15 *Abandoning the Black Hero* is the first book to examine the postwar African American white life novel novels with white protagonists written by African Americans These fascinating works have been understudied despite having been written by such defining figures in the tradition as Richard Wright Zora Neale Hurston James Baldwin Ann Petry and Chester Himes as well as lesser known but formerly best selling authors Willard Motley and Frank Yerby John C Charles argues that these fictions have been overlooked because they deviate from two critical suppositions that black literature is always about black life and that when it represents whiteness it must attack white supremacy The authors are however quite sympathetic in the treatment of their white protagonists which Charles contends should be read not as a failure of racial pride but instead as a strategy for claiming creative freedom expansive moral authority and critical agency In an era when Negro writers were expected to protest their sympathetic treatment of white suffering grants these authors a degree of racial privacy previously unavailable to them White writers after all have the privilege of racial privacy because they are never pressured to write only about white life Charles reveals that the freedom to abandon the Negro problem encouraged these authors to explore a range of new genres and themes generating a strikingly diverse body of novels that significantly revise our understanding of mid twentieth century black writing **Dreaming Out Loud** Horace Porter, 2015-04-15 *Dreaming Out Loud* brings together essays by many of the most well known and respected African American writers of the twentieth and twenty first centuries discussing various aspects of the vocation craft and art of writing fiction Though many of the writers included here are also accomplished poets essayists and playwrights this collection and the essays it contains remains focused on the novel as a genre and an art form Some essays explore the challenges of being an African American writer in the United States broadly addressing aesthetic and racial prejudice in American publishing and literature and its changing face over the decades Others are more specific and personal recounting how the authors came to be a reader and writer in a culture that did not always encourage them to do so

Some are more general and focus on practice and craft while still other essays offer detailed behind the scenes accounts of how famous novels such as *Native Son* *Invisible Man* *The Autobiography of Miss Jane Pittman* and *The Color Purple* came to life Ranging from the Harlem Renaissance through the Civil Rights movement and into the twenty first century this anthology explores what it has meant to be an African American novelist over the past hundred years Found within are essays by twenty one African American novelists including Nobel Prize winner Toni Morrison National Book Award winners Ralph Ellison and Charles Johnson Pulitzer Prize winners Alice Walker and James Alan McPherson and well known canonical writers such as W E B Du Bois James Weldon Johnson Langston Hughes Richard Wright Zora Neale Hurston and Margaret Walker *Dreaming Out Loud* seeks to inspire writers and readers alike while offering a fascinating and important portrait of novelists at work in their own words

Come Back in September Darryl Pinckney, 2022-10-25 Critic and writer Darryl Pinckney recalls his friendship and apprenticeship with Elizabeth Hardwick and Barbara Epstein and the introduction they offered him to the New York literary world Darryl Pinckney arrived at Columbia University in New York City in the early 1970s and had the opportunity to enroll in Elizabeth Hardwick's creative writing class at Barnard It changed his life When the semester was over he continued to visit her and he became close to both Hardwick and Barbara Epstein Hardwick's best friend and neighbor and a fellow founder of *The New York Review of Books* Pinckney was drawn into a New York literary world where he encountered some of the fascinating contributors to the Review among them Susan Sontag Robert Lowell and Mary McCarthy Yet the intellectual and artistic freedom that Pinckney observed on West Sixty seventh Street could conflict with the demands of his politically minded family and their sense of the unavoidable lessons of black history In addition through his peers and former classmates such as Felice Rosser Jim Jarmusch Jean Michel Basquiat Lucy Sante Howard Brookner and Nan Goldin Pinckney witnessed the coming together of the New Wave scene in the East Village He experienced the avant garde life at the same time as he was discovering the sexual freedom brought by gay liberation It was his time for hope In *Come Back in September* through his memories of the city and of Hardwick we see the emergence and evolution of Pinckney himself as a writer

The several lives of Chester Himes, 1997 The Writings of Chester Himes are colored by a fascinating blend of hatred and tenderness of hard boiled realism and generous idealism His life was complex his relationships complicated How did this gifted son of a respectable southern black family become a juvenile delinquent How did he acquire self esteem and a new sense of identity by writing short stories while in the Ohio state penitentiary Drawn from his letters notebooks memoirs and fiction this straightforward account of Himes's varied episodic life attempts to trace the origins of his significant literary gift It details the socioeconomic familial and cultural background that fed his

ambivalent views on race in America His Deep South childhood his adolescence in the Midwest his young manhood in prison his years as a menial laborer his struggle as an author in California and New York City and finally his glory days as an expatriate and celebrity in France and Spain are plumbed deeply for their effects upon his creative urges and his works In his native country Himes is recalled more as the author of successful detective novels such as *Cotton Comes to Harlem* than as a practitioner of the art of fiction In France and Spain his adopted countries he is regarded as a literary master This critical biography is the bittersweet story of a troubled man who found salvation in writing [A Companion to Crime Fiction](#) Charles J.
