Short stories tend to be told through one character's point of view. The author creates a narrator to tell the story. It is through the narrator's perspective (through the narrator's eyes and mind) that readers learn what is happening in a story. Do not make the mistake of thinking that the narrator of a story is the author. Remember that the point of view and the narrator are tools created and used by the author in order to tell a story in a certain way.

- 1. Who is the narrator or speaker in the story? What point of view does the story use? Is the story told from a first-person perspective, in which the narrator is one of the characters in the story, and refers to himself or herself as "I"? Or is the story told from a third-person perspective, in which the narrator is not one of the characters in the story or may not participate in the events of the story?
- 2. How are the characters presented? Directly through the narrator? Indirectly through behavior, thoughts, dialogue or speech? What is the author's attitude to the characters? Are we meant to sympathize with the characters or criticize him/ her? Are they static/flat characters who do not change? Are they dynamic/round characters who DO change?



Conflict or tension is usually the heart of the short story and is related to the main character. In a short story there is usually one main struggle.

- 3. How would you describe the main conflict?
- 4. Comment on the short story's timeline.
- 5. Does Lola's bitterness seem like natural sisterly jealousy to you? Or, is it simply a reaction to all of the attention that Morna has received because of her eating disorder?
- 6. What is the writer trying to make us see or understand? Hidden, unsaid conclusions?
- 7. Why does Lola see her sister's ghost with a dog at the end?

The theme is the main idea, lesson or message in the short story. It is usually an abstract idea about the human condition, society or life. It reveals the intention of the story.
