 The law of nature becomes a doctrine about self—preservation, not human flourishing. When this takes place, Locke and Hobbes suggest that individuals can exercise autonomy in determining what kind of life to live.

Aristotle and Aquinas had maintained that man is a social and political animal who becomes fully human only in society; Locke argues that men are equal and independent in a state of nature. Men, in other words, are naturally individualistic.

Rights in the natural law tradition are derived from the law of nature, but they are understood as spheres in which the government cannot interfere, not as obligations and duties.

 The role of government becomes limited to the protection of rights, not the fulfillment of human excellence.
