Colorado Madams Michael Rutter, In 1858 prospectors discovered gold where Cherry Creek meets the South Platte River today's downtown Denver sparking a gold rush that drew more than 100 000 fortune seekers to the territory Among them were enterprising women seeking their own motherlode riches dug straight from the pockets of miners merchants railroad workers and any other men with money to burn Forget your stodgy high school American history class The madams of early Colorado were more complex and far more brazen than conventional western lore might lead you to believe In Colorado Madams Meet Ada Lamont a preacher's widow turned prostitute perhaps the first woman to advertise her wares on Cherry Creek And Verona Baldwin scandalized by one of the wealthiest men in California only to turn her shame into fame as the owner of the most exclusive parlor house in Denver Here too is Laura Evens who once attended a costume ball dressed as a nun and Trinidad's savvy Mae Phelps a leader in offering health care to working girls and a founder of a rest home for retired prostitutes As told by author Michael Rutter the stories of these women come alive with voluptuous detail authentic photographs and historical context Make yourself comfortable and enter the seductive world of Colorado Madams

fought in the name of liberty In popular imagination the Revolution stands for the triumph of populism and the death of patriarchal elites But this is not the case argues Mark E Kann Rather in the aftermath of the Revolution America developed a society and system of laws that kept patriarchal authority alive and well especially when it came to the sex lives of citizens In *Taming Passion for the Public Good* Kann contends that that despite the rhetoric of classical liberalism the founding generation did not trust ordinary citizens with extensive liberty Through the policing of sex elites sought to maintain control of individuals private lives ensuring that citizens would be productive moral and orderly in the new nation New American elites applauded traditional marriages in which men were the public face of the family and women managed the home They frowned on interracial and interclass sexual unions They saw masturbation as evidence of a lack of self control over one s passions and they considered prostitution the result of aggressive female sexuality Both were punishable offenses By seeking to police sex elites were able to keep alive what Kann calls a resilient patriarchy Under the guise of paternalism they were able simultaneously to retain social control while espousing liberal principles with the goal of ultimately molding the country into the new American ideal a moral and orderly citizenry that voluntarily did what was best for the public good [Montana Madams](#) Nann Parrett,2017-01-13 Men flooded to the Montana frontier for gold furs rich land and jobs Women followed but their options were more limited Here are stories of women who made a desperate choice turning the law of supply and demand to their advantage Many eked out a meager but independent existence grit and business acumen brought remarkable wealth and influence even respectability to a few From Alzada to Yaak these enterprising women shaped Montana communities in some cases helping to fund social programs and public education [Revolvers and Pistolas, Vaqueros and Caballeros](#) D.
