War Stories Stephen G. MacDonald, 2011 *War Stories An Enlisted Marine In Vietnam* is a memoir of my two years in the United States Marine Corps. It tells what it was like to enlist in the Marine Corps and serve as a field radio operator with an infantry battalion. We operated near the southern edge of the DMZ in Vietnam in 1967, a time and place of intense fighting. It took forty years of writing and rewriting to distill that two years into this book because it took that long for me to become this honest about my experience. I'm glad I didn't rush it because none of the earlier versions were as good as this one. This book is not so much about military tactics as it is about what it feels like to be a Marine. It might be of particular interest to young people considering enlistment in the Marine Corps, to Marine officers both commissioned and non-commissioned, and to family members of Marines, but it is really written for everyone. Most of us believe that the world is less than ideal and that there are people and countries out there from whom we need to defend ourselves. Marines and the Marine Corps are an important part of that defense. When we ask citizens to become Marines to defend us, we owe it to them to try to understand what we are asking. This book can help. A common reaction of many early readers has been, "I had no idea it was like that."

Smith, U.S. Marine Corps History and Museums Division, 2021-05-03 This volume details the change in United States policy for the Vietnam War After a thorough review President Richard M Nixon adopted a policy of seeking to end United States military involvement in Vietnam either through negotiations or failing that turning the combat role over to the South Vietnamese It was this decision that began the Vietnamization of the war in the summer of 1969 and which would soon greatly reduce and then end the Marine Corps combat role in the war The Marines of III Marine Amphibious Force continued the full range of military and pacification activities within I Corps Tactical Zone during this period of transition Until withdrawn the 3rd Marine Division employing highly mobile tactics successfully blunted North Vietnamese Army efforts to reintroduce troops and supplies into Quang Tri Province The 1st Marine Division concentrated in Quang Nam Province continued both mobile offensive and pacification operations to protect the city of Da Nang and surrounding population centers The 1st Marine Aircraft Wing provided air support to both divisions as well as other allied units in I Corps while Force Logistic Command served all major Marine commands Although written from the perspective of III MAF and the Marine ground war in I Corps an attempt has been made to place the Marine role in relation to the overall American effort The volume also treats the Marine Corps participation in the advisory effort the operations of the Seventh Fleet Special Landing Force and to a lesser extent the activities of the 101st Airborne Division Airmobile 23rd Infantry Americal Division and 1st Brigade 5th Infantry Division Mechanized There are separate chapters on Marine air artillery surveillance and

readiness to be the first to every fight Yet even in a group that is known for innovation culture can push leaders to fall back on ingrained preferences Jeannie L Johnson takes a sympathetic but critical look at the Marine Corps's long experience with counterinsurgency warfare Which counterinsurgency lessons have been learned and retained for next time and which have been abandoned to history is a story of battlefield trial and error but also a story of cultural collisions The book begins with a fascinating and penetrating look inside the culture of the Marine Corps through research in primary sources including Marine oral histories and interviews with Marines Johnson explores what makes this branch of the military distinct their identity norms values and perceptual lens She then traces the history of the Marines counterinsurgency experience from the expeditionary missions of the early twentieth century through the Vietnam War and finally to the Iraq War Her findings break new ground in strategic culture by introducing a methodology that was pioneered in the intelligence community to forecast behavior Johnson shows that even a service as self aware and dedicated to innovation as the Marine Corps is constrained in the lessons learned process by its own internal predispositions by the wider US military culture and by national preferences Her findings challenge the conclusions of previous counterinsurgency scholarship that ignores culture This highly readable book reminds us of Sun Tzu's wisdom that to be successful in war it is important to know thyself as well as the enemy This is a must read for anyone interested in the Marines Corps counterinsurgency warfare military innovation or strategic culture
