Optical Margin Alignment outdents letters like A W V T O C and punctuation into the margins so that the edge of the block of text appears to be straight on the printed page.

A V W and T are outdented by about 20% to compensate for the large amount of white space. Punctuation like '.; : or are outdented 100% while a hyphen needs 75% and an em-dash only 25%.

Curved letters, O C or G, may need only 10% and the capital T may need 15 or 20% depending on the typeface design. The text frames are visible in this screen shot to emphasise the outdenting of letters and punctuation, but if the chosen values are correct for the typeface, the margins should look straight when the text is printed.
