recipients a strange sort of book it is impossible to begin and not finish it and quite as impossible to lay it aside afterwards and say nothing about it As a reader and especially as a student of English I feel a rather large obligation to look deeper into the differences and controversies that the novel in question has caused during the last hundred and fifty years and thus to also get a better sense of awareness how the field of literature is subject to cultural and historical changes as a whole Wuthering Heights appears to be an especially apt piece of literature to exemplify these dynamics being at work as will be subsequently shown However I will also arrive at the conclusion that a certain tendency in opinions concerning the novel overwhelms I will attempt to examine various aspects such as language gender of the author and the estimation of his abilities etc in order to gain some insights The retracing of opinions will be supported by a second part of this research paper dealing with the time in which Emily Bronte created her first and only novel
